$1 / 2$ yard $(0.46 \mathrm{~m}) \quad$ Verona - Yellow (D) 2311-44
$1 / 2$ yard $(0.46 \mathrm{~m}) \quad$ Verona - Turquoise (E) 2311-70
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Fish - Dark Blue (F) 2961-77
$1 / 4$ yard $(0.23 \mathrm{~m}) \quad$ Bugs - White $(\mathrm{G}) \quad$ 2964-01
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Cattails with Dragonflies - Dark Blue (H) 2967-77
$1 / 4$ yard (0.23 m) Tossed Frogs - White (I) 2960-01
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Scenic Frog - Turquoise (J) 2966-70
$1 / 4$ yard $(0.23 \mathrm{~m}) \quad$ Leaves - Dark Blue (K) 2965-77
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Dragonflies - Turquoise (L) 2963-70
3 yards ( 2.75 m ) Dragonflies - Turquoise (Backing) 2963-70

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the Pond Panel - 24 inches - Turquoise (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $201 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Verona - Evergreen (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 401 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 231 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 431 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Verona - Orange (C), cut:
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
-(2) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 241 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Verona - Yellow (D), cut:

- (4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Verona - Turquoise (E), cut:

- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Fish - Dark Blue (F), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bugs - White (G), cut:
-(1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $6^{1 / 2 "}$ squares and (1) $6^{1 / 2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ strip.

From the Cattails with Dragonflies - Dark Blue (H), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Frogs - White (I), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $6^{1 / 2 "}$ squares and (1) $6^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strip.

From the Scenic Frog - Turquoise (J), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Leaves - Dark Blue (K), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Dragonflies - Turquoise (L), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Dragonflies - Turquoise (Backing), cut:
-(2) $51 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $51 " \times 71 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $201 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $231 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$.

2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $6^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric F square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make (1) $81 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Block One square.

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures $3-8$ for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Two squares, (2) Block Three squares, (4) Block Four squares, (2) Block Five squares, (2) Block Six squares and (2) Block Seven squares.

4. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of
(1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Fabric E strip to make (1) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ Block Eight rectangle.
5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 10 for fabric identification and placement to make (1) Block Nine rectangle.

6. Sew together (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Eight rectangle, (1) Block Seven square and (1) Block Four square, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 11).
7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 12-14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 8. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
10. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $431 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
