







¼ yard	Tiles - Purple (B)	1734-55
⅞ yard	Starlet - Ivory (C)	6383-Ivory
¼ yard	Grapes - Light Green (D)	1735-60
½ yard	Wine Glasses - Light Pink (E)	1732-20
½ yard	Wine Lace - Light Purple (F)	1733-50
¼ yard	Grapes - Light Pink (G)	1735-20
1 ½ yards	Wine Coasters - Pink (H)	1736-22
½ yard	Tiles - Pink (I)	1734-22*
¼ yard	Tiles - Green (J)	1734-66
3 ¼ yards	Grapes - Light Green (Backing)	1735-60

*Includes binding

Batting: 56" x 68"
(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Wine Glasses - Light Green (A), cut:

- (2) 6 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal (upper right corner to lower left corner) to make (24) 6 ⅞" triangles. Note: You will only use (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Tiles - Purple (B), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Ivory (C), cut:

- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (96) 3 ⅞" triangles.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

From the Grapes - Light Green (D), cut:

- (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Wine Glasses - Light Pink (E), cut:

- (2) 6 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal (upper right corner to lower left corner) to make (24) 6 ⅞" triangles. Note: You will only use (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Wine Lace - Light Purple (F), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ½" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.

From the Grapes - Light Pink (G), cut:

- (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Wine Coasters - Pink (H), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 52 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tiles - Pink (I), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tiles - Green (J), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Grapes - Light Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 68" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric C triangle to adjacent sides of (1) 3 ½" Fabric B square. Sew (1) 6 ⅞" Fabric A triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). The block should measure 6 ½" square. Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (12) Block Two squares, (12) Block Three squares and (12) Block Four squares.







3. Follow Figure 5 and sew together the (48) Blocks into a 6 x 8 matrix to make the Center Block. The block should measure 36 1/2" x 48 1/2".



Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

4. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
5. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric J square to each end of (1) 4 1/2" x 40 1/2" strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

7. Layer and quilt as desired.

8. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

9. Bind as desired.
