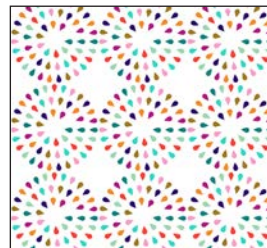

Punchbowl - Quilt 1

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width

1/4 yard 2174-33 Fruits with Drops - Orange
1/4 yard 2175-33 Lemons - Orange
1/4 yard 2176-22 Mini Fruits - Pink
1/4 yard 2177-75 Raindrops - Dk. Blue
1/4 yard 2177-79 Raindrops - Teal
1/4 yard 2180-25 Flowers with Stems - Fuchsia
1/4 yard 2181-50 Circle Stars with Stems - Periwinkle
5/8 yard 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow
5/8 yard 2174-76 Fruits with Drops - Turquoise
2/3 yard 2175-79 Lemons - Teal
2/3 yard 2176-33 Mini Fruits - Orange
3/4 yard 9570-76 Jot Dot - Teal
1 yard 2178-01 Circle Raindrops - White
2 yards 2179-01 Leaves - White
3-3/4 yards 2173-01 Fruits with Stars & Raindrops - White for backing
65" x 71" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting
Plastic for template

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From each:

2174-33 Fruits with Drops – Orange

2180-25 Flowers with Stems – Fuchsia

2175-33 Lemons - Orange

2176-22 Mini Fruits – Pink

*Cut one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut five 5-1/4" squares.

From each:

2177-75 Raindrops - Dk. Blue

2177-79 Raindrops – Teal

*Cut one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 5-1/4" squares.

From 2181-50 Circle Stars with Stems – Periwinkle:

*Cut one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 5-1/4" squares.

From 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow:

*Cut eleven 1-1/2" x WOF strips for borders 3 and 5.

From 2175-79 Lemons – Teal:

*Cut four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut sixty 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

*Cut one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 5-1/4" squares.

From 2176-33 Mini Fruits – Orange:

*Cut one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut six 5-1/4" squares.

*Cut four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut sixty 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

From 9570-76 Jot Dot – Teal:

*Cut five 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

*Cut seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 2174-76 Fruits with Drops – Turquoise:

*Cut one 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Four 5-1/4" squares

- Four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

- Four 2-1/2" squares

*Cut five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 4.

From 2178-01 Circle Raindrops – White:

*Cut five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 120 1-1/2" squares.

*Cut ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:

- Four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

- Four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

- 124 2-1/2" squares

From 2179-01 Leaves – White:

*Cut four 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

*Cut 84 wedges with template A.

*Cut 84 wedges with template B.

Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.










Table 1. Block colorway and quantity.

1. Trace templates A and B on the plastic to make templates and **label** them. Cut on the outline. Trace **each template** eighty-four times on the wrong side of the 2179-01 Leaves – White fabric using a fabric marker. Cut on the outline using a ruler and a rotary cutter. Separate them into different groups: wedges A will be used with the left-leaning blocks, and wedges B with the right-leaning ones.

2. Position the wide end of a Leaves – White wedge A on the top left corner of a 5-1/4" 2176-22 Mini Fruits – Pink square, right sides together, and pin the entire length. Sew the pieces together and press open. Working clockwise, sew the next Leaves – White wedge as before. Continue until you have sewn the four wedges (*figure 1*). Repeat with the 5-1/4" squares of 2180-25 Flowers with Stems – Fuchsia, 2176-33 Mini Fruits – Orange, and 2175-33 Lemons – Orange to make a total of twenty-one Left-leaning 6-1/2" blocks of assorted colors.

3. Repeat Step 2 with the Leaves – White wedges B and the 5-1/4" squares of 2174-76 Fruits with Drops – Turquoise, 2174-33 Fruits with Drops – Orange, 2177-79 Raindrops – Teal, 2177-75 Raindrops - Dk. Blue, 2175-79 Lemons – Teal, and 2181-50 Circle Stars with Stems – Periwinkle, except aligning the narrow end of the wedge to the top left corner of the squares and continuing as before. Make a total of twenty-one Right-leaning 6-1/2" blocks of assorted colors (*figure 2*).

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 2-1/2" 2179-01 Leaves – White square. With right sides together, layer a marked Leaves - White square on the left short end of a 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" 2175-79 Lemons – Teal rectangle and stitch on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam line and press open. Similarly, stitch a 1-1/2" 2179-01 Leaves – White square to the opposite end of the same Teal rectangle (*figure 3*). Repeat to make a total of sixty Teal 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" units.

5. Repeat Step 4 with the 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" 2176-33 Mini Fruits – Orange rectangles, this time sewing the 1-1/2" 2179-01 Leaves – White square to the left side of each rectangle, and the 2-1/2" Leaves – White square to the right side (*figure 4*). Press the seams open. Make sixty Orange 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" units.

6. Noting fabric orientation, sew the Step 4 and Step 5 units together and press the seams open (*figure 5, next page*). Make sixty 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.

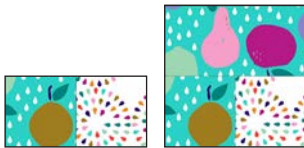


Figure 6 – Make 4.

7. Sew together one 2-1/2” 2179-01 Leaves – White square and one 2-1/2” 2174-76 Fruits with Drops – Turquoise square. Press the seam toward the dark fabric. Repeat to make four strips. Sew one 2-1/2” x 4-1/2” 2174-76 Fruits with Drops – Turquoise rectangle on top of the strips (*figure 6*). Press the seams toward the last addition.

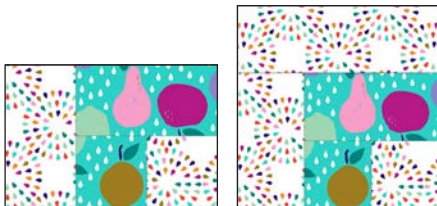


Figure 7 – Make (4) 6-1/2” blocks.

8. Sew a 2-1/2” x 4-1/2” 2179-01 Leaves – White rectangle to the left side of the Step 7 units. Press the seams toward the rectangle. Sew a 2-1/2” x 6-1/2” Leaves – White rectangle to the top of all the units to make four 6-1/2” corner blocks (*figure 7*). Press as before.

Assemble Quilt Top

9. Following the quilt photo for block placement, lay out seven rows of six blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row, then matching adjacent seams sew the rows together in order.

10. For border 1, join the four 1-1/2” 2179-01 Leaves – White strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the

width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

11. Repeat Step 10 with the five 1-1/2” 9570-76 Jot Dot – Teal strips to make and add border 2.

12. Repeat Step 10 with the five 1-1/2” 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow strips to make and add border 3. Save the remaining strip for the last border. The quilt measures 42-1/2” x 48-1/2” up to here.

13. For the sides of border 4, sew together eight Step 6 strips and press the seams open. Repeat to make three more strips. Sew together the 2-1/2” 2174-76 Fruits with Drops – Turquoise strips as in step 10. Cut two lengths at 48-1/2”. Noting strip orientation, sew a block strip to the top and one to the bottom of the Turquoise strips to make the side borders. Sew one border to each side of the quilt.

Cut the remaining Turquoise strip into two 42-1/2” lengths for the top and bottom border strips. Sew the Step 6 strips into four strips of seven blocks each. Noting block orientation, sew one block strip to the top and one to the bottom of the Turquoise strips. Sew one Step 8 corner block to each side of the strips. Sew one border to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt.

14. Repeat Step 10 with the leftover 1-1/2” 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow strip to make and add border 5.

Finishing

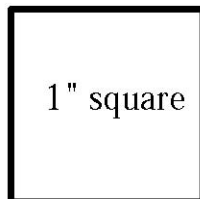
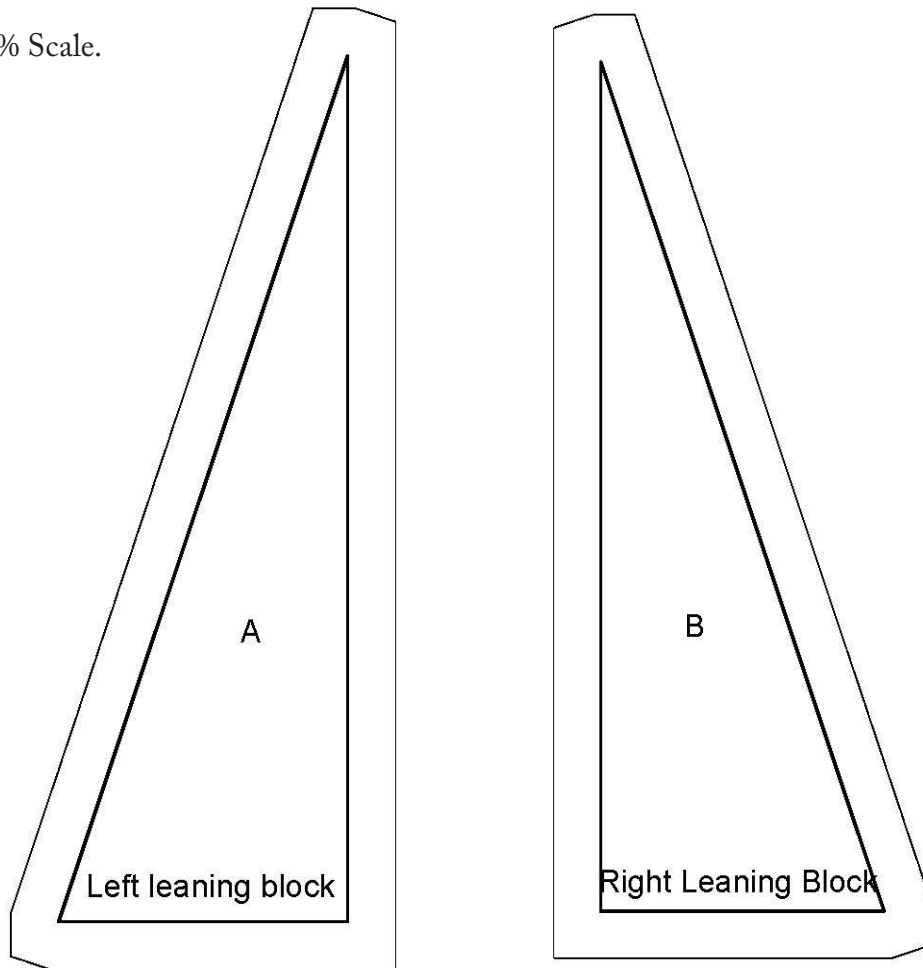
15. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

16. Join the seven 2-1/2” 9570-76 Jot Dot – Teal binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to

make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.

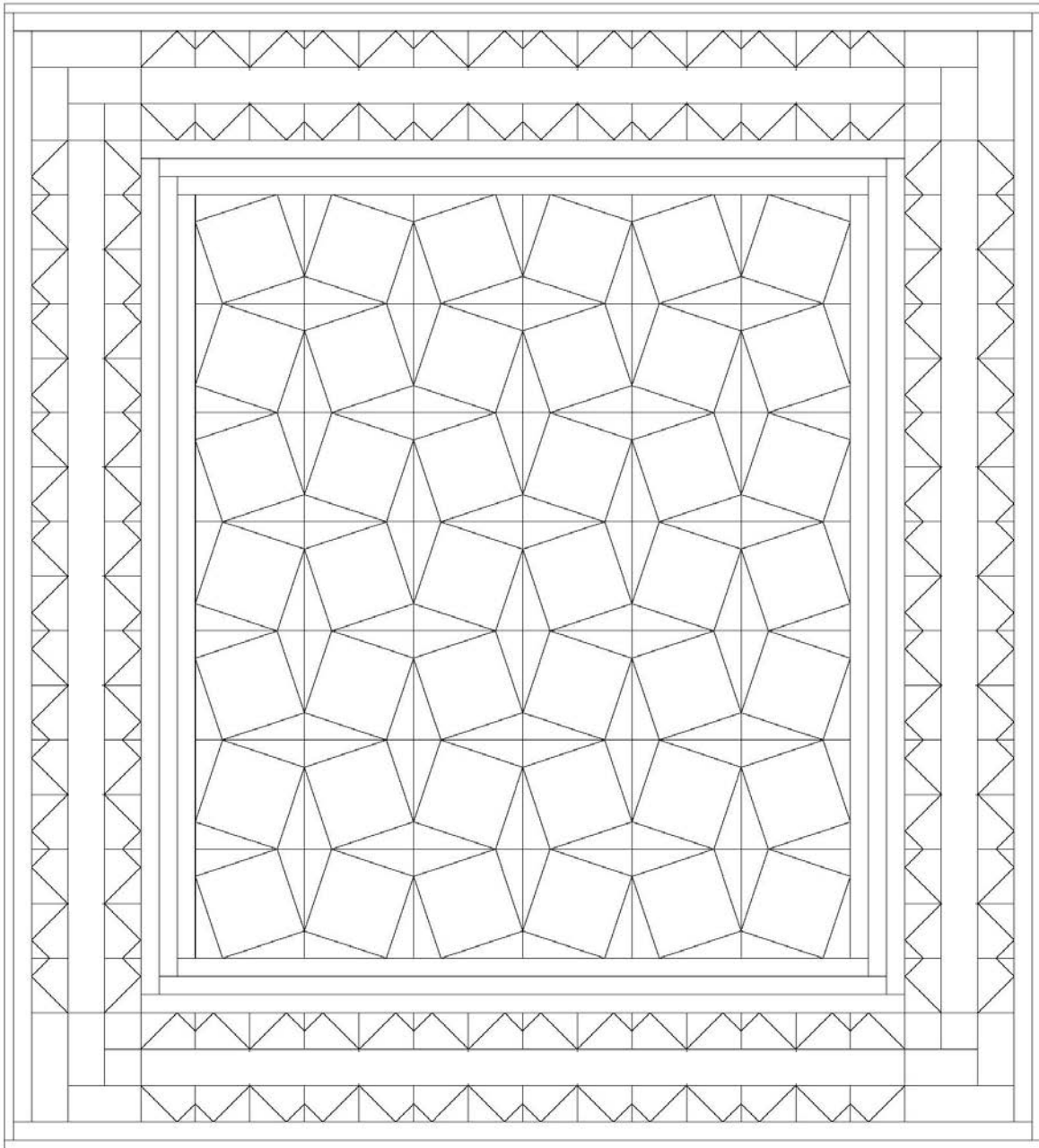
