

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width

1/8 yard 2998-01 Selvedges - White
1/4 yard 2997-99 Quilting Bingo Cards - Black
1/4 yard 2999-75 Fat Quarter Bundles - Turquoise
1/4 yard 3002-88 Quilting Ladies Patch - Red
1/4 yard 6383 Starlet - Red
1/4 yard 6383 Starlet - Orange
1/4 yard 6383 Starlet - Pink
5/8 yard 3003-99 Coffee Cups and Snacks - Black
2/3 yard 6383 Starlet - Royal
7/8 yard 3000-67 Tossed Sewing Motifs - Teal
2-1/8 yards 3004-01 Meandering Stitches - White
3-3/4 yards 2995-67 Fabric Swatches on Cutting Board – Teal for backing
66" x 78" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 2998-01 Selvedges – White: *Cut one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 3-1/2" squares.

From each: 2997-99 Quilting Bingo Cards – Black 2999-75 Fat Quarter Bundles – Turquoise 3002-88 Quilting Ladies Patch – Red *Cut two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty 3-1/2" squares.

From each: 6383 Starlet - Red 6383 Starlet - Orange 6383 Starlet – Pink *Cut one 3-7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 3-7/8" squares.

From 3003-99 Coffee Cups and Snacks – Black:

*Cut two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four 3-1/2" squares. (A) *Cut three 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut: - Twenty 4-1/4" squares; cut twice diagonally. (B)

- Six 3-1/2" squares, for a total of 30.

From 6383 Starlet – Royal:

*Cut one 3-7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 3-7/8" squares. *Cut seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 3000-67 Tossed Sewing Motifs – Teal:

*Cut two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty 3-1/2" squares. *Cut six 3-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White:

*Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty-six 3-1/2" squares.

- *Cut eight 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:
- Forty 3-7/8" squares.
- Forty 3-7/8" squares; cut once diagonally. (C)
- *Cut three 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:
- Twenty 4-1/4" squares; cut twice diagonally. (D)
- Four 3-1/2" squares, for a total of 40.

*Cut thirteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips: six for border 1 and seven for border 3.

From 2995-67 Fabric Swatches on Cutting Board – Teal:

*Cut two 66" x WOF panels, pieced horizontally.

Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include ¹/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.



Table 1. Fabric combinations for each block.




Figure 1 – Make (20) 6-1/2" units.

 Sew a 3003-99 Coffee Cups and Snacks – Black B triangle to a 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White D triangle. Press the seam toward the darker fabric. Sew a 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White C triangle to the unit. Press the seam toward the C triangle. Repeat to make eighty 3-1/2" units. Sew the units together as shown to make twenty 6-1/2" patches (*figure 1*). Press the seams in one direction.

 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of forty 3-7/8" 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White squares. With right sides together, layer the marked White squares atop the 3-7/8" 6383 Starlet Royal, Red, Pink, and Orange squares. Stitch ¼" from each side of the diagonal line, cut on the drawn line, press each unit open with seams toward the darker fabric, and trim dog ears (*figure* 2). Make a total of twenty 3-1/2" half-square triangles (HST) of each type.




Figure 2 – Make (20) 3-1/2" units of each type.




Figure 3 – Make (10) 6-1/2" units.

 Sew two Step 2 Royal HST, one 3-1/2" 2999-75 Fat Quarter Bundles – Turquoise square, and one 3-1/2" 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White square to make a 6-1/2" unit (*figure 3*). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make ten units.

4. Sew two 3-1/2" 2999-75 Fat Quarter Bundles

Turquoise squares and two 3-1/2" 300399 Coffee Cups and Snacks – Black squares together to make a 6-1/2" unit (*figure 4*). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make five units.




Figure 5 – Make (5) 12-1/2" blocks.

5. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 3 unit to a Step 4 one to make a row. Press the seams in one direction. Sew a Step 1 unit to another Step 3 unit. Then, sew these two rows to make a 12-1/2" block (*figure 5*). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make five blocks.

6. Referring to Table 1 for fabric combinations, repeat Steps 3 to 5 to make five 12-1/2" blocks of each type (*figure 6, next page*).

Assemble Quilt Top

- Following the quilt photo for block placement and orientation, lay out five rows of four blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row, then matching adjacent seams, sew the rows together in order.
- For border 1, join six 1-1/2" 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips.

Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.


- Repeat Step 8 with the six 3-1/2" 3000-67 Tossed Sewing Motifs – Teal strips to make and add border 2.
- Repeat Step 8 with seven 1-1/2" 3004-01 Meandering Stitches – White strips to make and add border 3.

Finishing

- 11. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with the raw edges of the quilt top.
- 12. Join the seven 2-1/2" 6383 Starlet Royal binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold the binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
