



# Reflections - Quilt 2

#### Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1/2 yard 9570-44 Jot Dot - Yellow

1/2 yard 9570-20 Jot Dot - Lt. Pink

1/2 yard 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia

1/2 yard 9570-60 Jot Dot - Chartreuse

1/2 yard 2085-22 Flowers - Pink

1/2 yard 2086-88 Light Through the Trees - Red

1/2 yard 2089-75 Abstract Circles - Blue

5/8 yard 2088-70 Linear Geometric - Lt. Blue

5/8 yard 6383 Starlet - Royal

1-1/8 yards 2090-55 Abstract Tree Trunks - Purple

3-1/4 yards 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow

4-1/8 yards 2084-70 Trees - Lt. Blue for backing

71" x 83" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting

Fusible Web

Plastic for template

Monofilament or threads to match fabrics

#### **Cut Fabrics**

**Note:** All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

#### From each:

1/2 yard 9570-44 Jot Dot - Yellow

1/2 yard 9570-20 Jot Dot - Lt. Pink

1/2 yard 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia

1/2 yard 9570-60 Jot Dot - Chartreuse

\*Cut one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut fourteen 3" squares.

\*Cut twenty petals with the B template and six 3" squares (for a total of 20).

#### From *each*:

**2085-22 Flowers – Pink:** 

2086-88 Light Through the Trees – Red

2089-75 Abstract Circles - Blue

\*Cut twenty diamonds with the A template.

\*Cut twenty crowns with the C template.

#### From 2088-70 Linear Geometric - Lt. Blue:

\*Cut twenty-three 1-1/4" x **LOF strips** for borders 2 and 4.

#### From 6383 Starlet – Royal:

\*Cut seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

#### From 2090-55 Abstract Tree Trunks – Purple:

\*Cut seven 3" x WOF strips for border 3.

\*Cut twenty diamonds with the A template.

\*Cut twenty crowns with the C template.

#### From 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow:

\*Cut seven 12-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty 12-1/2" squares.

\*Cut thirteen 2" x WOF strips: six for border 1, seven for border 5.

#### Assemble Blocks

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.




Figure 1 - Make 20.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the twenty 3" 9570-44 Jot Dot - Yellow squares. With right sides together, place one marked Yellow square on a corner of one 12-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow square and stitch on the drawn line. Repeat with the opposite corner of the same square. Trim the seam allowances to ¼" and press open. Repeat with the other corners of the square (figure 1).

Repeat this step with the remaining 12-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow squares and the 3" 9570-20 Jot Dot - Lt. Pink, 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia, and 9570-60 Jot Dot - Chartreuse squares. Separate the twenty 12-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow squares into four piles of five squares each.

2. Trace shapes A, B, and C on the plastic to make templates. Cut on the outline. Trace the shapes on




Figure 2 – Fusible web shapes ready to be fuses to the wrong side of fabrics.

the smooth side of the fusible web twenty times each. Cut them 1/8" outside the outline, then, using sharp scissors, remove the center of the fusible web inside the diamonds and the petals leaving about 3/8" near the edges, making them hollow (*figure 2*). Fuse the shapes to the wrong side of the fabrics as listed in Table 1 below, cut on the outline, and remove the paper backing. Group the appliqué shapes by color atop each pile of Marshmallow squares to ensure colors are not mixed.




Figure 3 Make (20) 12-1/2" blocks.

3. Working with one pile at a time, fold and crease the 12-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow squares in half twice. Position the diamond appliqué shapes on squares using the creased folds as guidelines and making sure the points are 1/4" away from the edges of the squares so the seams won't hide them once the blocks come together. Add the petals and the crowns, and fuse them according to the manufacturer's instructions (figure 3, next page).

Machine appliqué using the monofilament (with a small zig-zag stitch) or matching thread (with the blanket stitch).

Note: Once the shapes are in place, you may want to fuse the diamonds and petals at their touching point at the center of the square first, so they will not slide out of place. Then, when satisfied with the position of their sides and the crowns, continue to fuse.

#### **Assemble Quilt Top**

- 4. For border 1, sew six 2" 9570-09 Jot Dot Marshmallow border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 5. Repeat Step 4 with the 1-1/4" 2088-70 Linear Geometric Lt. Blue strips (cut on the LOF) to make and add border 2. Save the remaining length for border 4.


- 6. Repeat Step 4 with the 3" 2090-55 Abstract Tree Trunks Purple strips to make and add border 3.
- 7. Repeat Step 4 with the remaining 1-1/4" 2088-70 Linear Geometric Lt. Blue strips to make and add border 4.
- 8. Repeat Step 4 with the 2"9570-09 Jot Dot Marshmallow strips to make and add border 5.

#### Finishing

- 9. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
- 10. Join the seven 2-1/2" 6383 Starlet Royal binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
