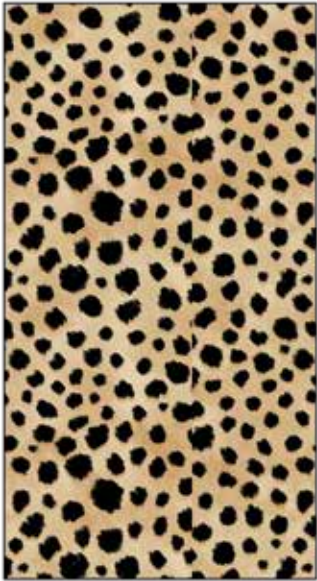

### Materials (Set of 3 Bags)

1/3 yard	Urban Legend - Black (A)	7101-98
1/3 yard	Cow Skin - Black/White (B)	1653-19
1/2 yard	Chameleon - Light Gray (C)	1178-90
1/4 yard	Tiger Skin - Rust (D)	1650-33
1/3 yard	Skin Collage - Medium Brown (E)	1652-35
1/8 yard	Urban Legend - Chocolate (F)	7101-37
1/4 yard	Giraffe Skin - Medium Brown (G)	1648-35
1/3 yard	Cheetah Skin - Tan (H)	1647-30

### You will also need:

- 1/2 yard Fusible Fleece
- (1) 11" zipper
- (1) 9" zipper
- (1) 7" zipper

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Urban Legend - Black (A), cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips

#### From the Cow Skin - Black/White (B), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

#### From the Chameleon - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 12" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 12" x 14 1/2" strips.

#### From the Tiger Skin - Rust (D), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips

#### From the Skin Collage - Medium Brown (E), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips

#### From the Urban Legend - Chocolate (F), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.

#### From the Giraffe Skin - Medium Brown (G), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips

#### From the Cheetah Skin - Tan (H), cut:

- (1) 8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8" x 9 1/2" strips.

### Bag Assembly

*Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

- Sew (1) 4" x 14 1/2" Fabric B strip to the bottom of (1) 8 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric A strip to make Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 rectangle.

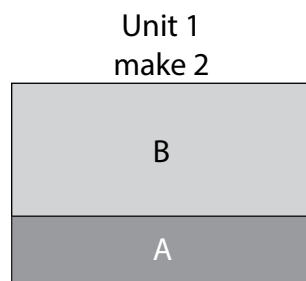

- Press (1) piece of Fusible Fleece to the wrong side of each Unit 1 rectangle and quilt as desired.

- Place (1) 12" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strip on a flat surface, right side up. Align the 11" Zipper with the top edge of the zipper, right side up as shown in Figure 2.

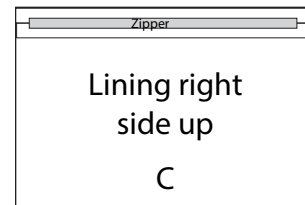

- Place (1) Unit 1 rectangle, right side down on the zipper, with the Fabric B edge at the top (Fig. 3).

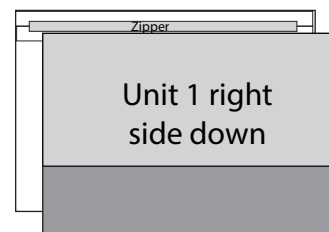

- Using a zipper foot, sew the three layers together (Fig. 4). Flip the sewn unit right side out (Fig. 5).

- Place the second 12" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strip on a flat surface. Place the other side of the zipper on top of the Fabric C piece right side up, aligning the top edges (Fig. 6). Place the second Unit 1 piece on top wrong side up (Fig. 7).

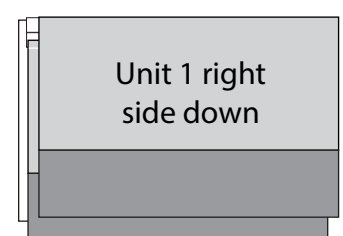

7. Using a zipper foot, sew the three layers together (Fig. 8).

8. Flip the sewn unit right side out so there is a Unit 1 and a Fabric C piece on each side of the zipper. Topstitch through the layers to finish the zipper (Fig. 9).

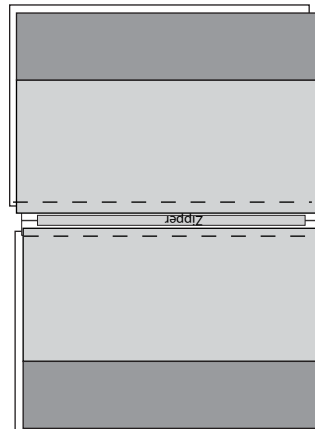

9. Unzip the zipper halfway to create an opening for turning. Flip the Unit 1 pieces, right side together and the Fabric C pieces right sides together, aligning the edges on both halves and pin (Fig. 10).

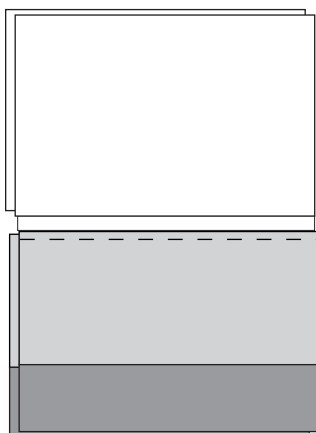

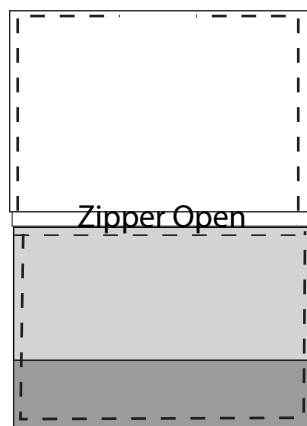

10. Stitch around the Unit 1 side and Fabric C sides, leaving a 3" to 4" opening on the Fabric C side for turning (Fig. 11).

11. Measure in from the side edge 1 1/2" and up from the bottom edge, 1 1/2" at each bottom corner. Cut out the square of fabric (Fig. 12). Open the cut bottom and align the bottom edge with the side edge and sew the two edges together (Fig. 13). Repeat with the other bottom corner to make the box bottom on the outer bag.

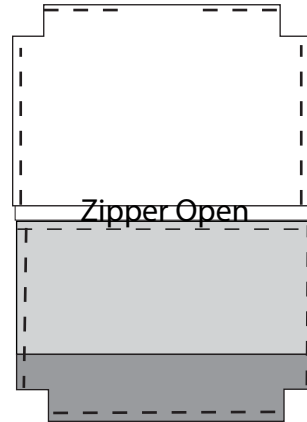

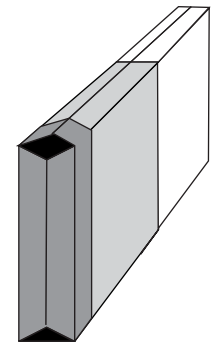

12. Repeat Step 11 with the two corners on the lining side of the bag.

13. Turn the zipper pouch right side out through the opening in the Fabric C side and through the open zipper. Stitch the lining opening closed (Fig. 14). Push the Fabric C side into the zipper pouch for the lining to finish the Large Bag.

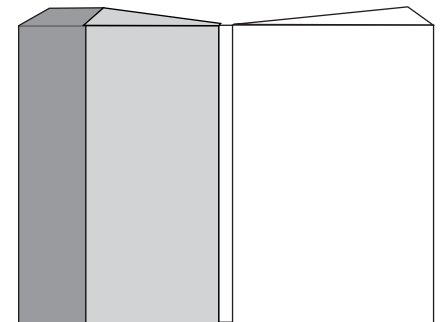

14. Repeat Steps 1-10 with (2) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A strips, (2) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strips, (2) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric E strips and the 9" zipper to make the Medium Pouch.

15. Repeat Step 11-12 to make the box bottom, measuring in 1" from the side and bottom edge to finish the Medium Pouch.

16. Repeat Steps 1-10 with (2) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric F strips, (2) 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric G strips, (2) 8" x 9 1/2" Fabric H strips and the 7" zipper to make the Small Pouch.

17. Repeat Step 11-12 to make the box bottom, measuring in 1" from the side and bottom edge to finish the Small Pouch.

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
