

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Panel - Purple (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 37" panel.

From the Stars - Black (B), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (2) 2 ½" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 37" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 24 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - Black (C), cut:

• (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Urban Legend - White (D), cut:

- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips, Sub-cut (64) 1 ½" x 4½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 8" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 10" strips.

From the Witches - Purple (E), cut:

• See instructions to cut (6) Tombstones.

From the Words - Gray (F), cut:

• See instructions to cut (5) Tombstones.

From the Pumpkins - Orange (G), cut:

• See instructions to cut (11) Tombstones.

From the Skeletons - Purple (H), cut:

• See instructions to cut (5) Tombstones.

From the Skulls - Black (I), cut:

• See instructions to cut (5) Tombstones.

From the Cemetery - Gray (J), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 40 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips from remaining fabric, piece as needed.

Page 1

From the Blocks - Black (K):

• Fussy cut (4) 8" blocks each centered on a block (2 orange and 2 purple).

From the Urban Legend - Dark Purple (L), cut:


- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 9" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Words - Gray (Backing), cut:


• (2) 52" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 52" x 68" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 37" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 37" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 40 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1)




2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 8" Fabric K Orange block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric K block. Trim the block to measure 9" square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.






3. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 9" Fabric L strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.




4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 8" Fabric K Purple block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric K block. Trim the block to measure 9" square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 square.



5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9" Fabric L strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 square.




6. Sew (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strips and (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (32) Unit 5 squares total.




- 7. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 8. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 9. Refer to Figure 7 to arrange and press (1) Fabric E Tombstone onto (1) Unit 5 square.



- 10. Finish the raw edges of the Tombstone with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Unit 6 square.
- 11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make (6) Unit 6 squares total.
- 12. Repeat Steps 9-10 and refer to Figures 8-11 for component identification and location to make (5) Unit 7 squares, (11) Unit 8 squares, (5) Unit 9 squares and (5) Unit 10 squares.




13. Sew (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 8 square, (1) Unit 9 square, (1) Unit 10 square and (1) Unit 8 square together, in that order, to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 12).




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14. Sew (1) Unit 9 square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 8 square, (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 10 square and (1) Unit 8 square together in that order to make (1) Unit 12 square (Fig. 13).



- 15. Sew (1) Unit 8 square,
- (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 10 square,
- (1) Unit 8 square, (1) Unit 9 square,
- (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 8 square,
- (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 10 square and (1) Unit 8 square together in that order to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 14).
- 16. Sew (1) Unit 6 square,
- (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 8 square,
- (1) Unit 9 square, (1) Unit 10 square, (1) Unit 8 square, (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 8 square and (1) Unit 9 square together in that order to make (1)




Note: Pay attention to the orientation of the Fabric J strip in Steps 17-20. The arrows in the figures represent the direction of the fabric print.

- 17. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to the left side of the Unit 13 strip. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric J strip to the left side of the Fabric B strip to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 16).
- 18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to the right side of the Unit 14 strip. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric J strip to the right side of the Fabric B strip to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 17).



19. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) Unit 11 strip. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric J strip to the top of the Fabric B strip to make (1) Unit 15 strip (Fig. 18).



20. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric B strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 12 strip. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric J strip to the bottom of the Fabric B strip to make (1) Unit 16 strip (Fig. 19).



- 21. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 15 strip. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the right side of the Unit 15 strip to make (1) Top Border strip (Fig. 20 below).
- 22. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left side of (1) Unit 16 strip. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the right side of the Unit 16 strip to make (1) Bottom Border strip (Fig. 21 below).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

23. Sew the Left Side and Right Side Borders onto the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the border strips.

- 24. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders onto the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the orientation of the border strips.
- 25. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 26. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 27. Bind as desired.






