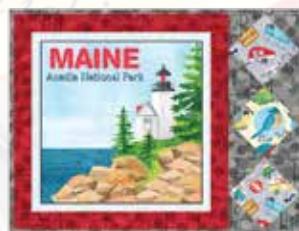
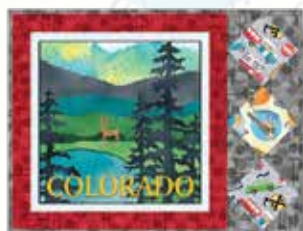

3/8 yard	Jot Dots - Red (B)	9570-88
1/4 yard	State Birds - Yellow (C)	2118-44
5/8 yard	State Flowers - Gray (D)	2119-95
1/4 yard	Jot Dots- Light Blue (E)	9570-11
7/8 yard	Welcome To ... Signs - Red (F)	2120-88
1/2 yard	Jot Dots - Charcoal (G)	9570-92*
3 yards	Tossed RV's - Light Gray (Backing)	2116-90

Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the State Blocks - Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 10 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Jot Dots - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 13 1/2" strips.

From the State Birds - Yellow (C), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" square.

From the State Flowers - Gray (D), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 28 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 31 1/2" WOF strips

From the Jot Dots - Light Blue (E), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x 31 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Welcome To ... Signs - Red (F), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 33 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips.

From the Jot Dots - Charcoal (G), cut:

- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed RV's - Light Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 51" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 51" x 51" back.

Table Topper Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"**. Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

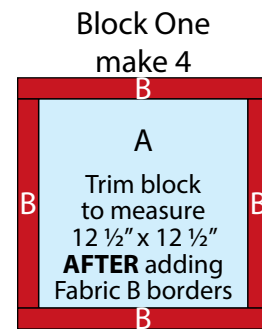

2. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip to make the top row. Repeat to make bottom row. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make the Center Block (Fig. 2).

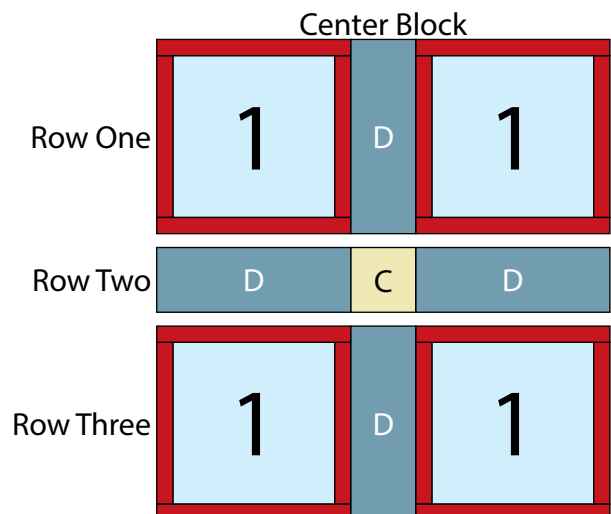

Table Topper Assembly

(Follow the Table Topper Layout in Figure 3 while assembling the topper.)

3. Sew (1) 2" x 28 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 31 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

4. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 31 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

5. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 33 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Table Topper.

6. Layer and quilt as desired.

7. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

8. Bind as desired.

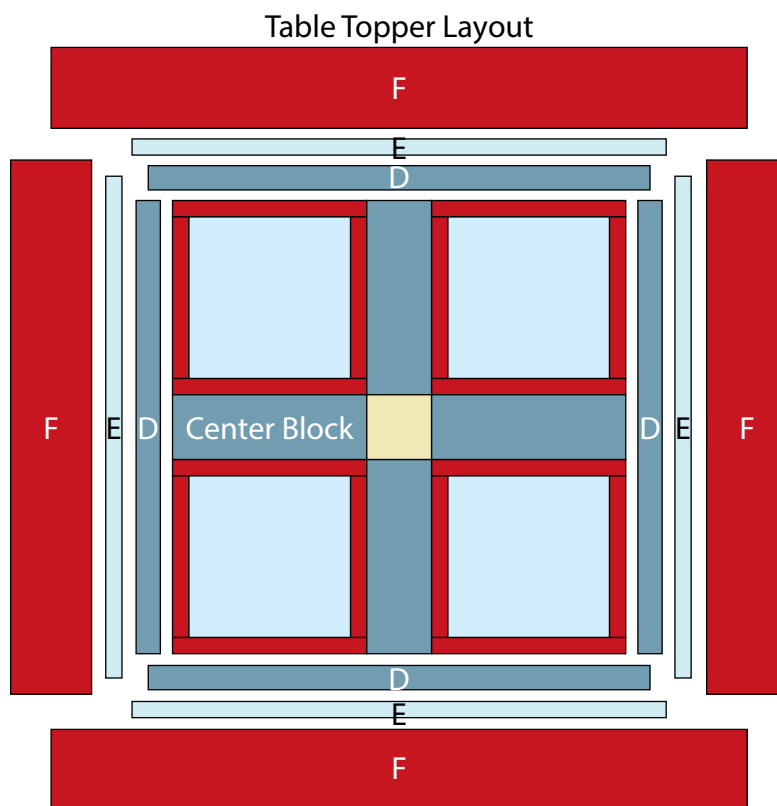

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the State Blocks - Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 10 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Jot Dots - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 13 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed RV's - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 1/2" squares.

From the State Birds - Yellow (D), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Jot Dots - Charcoal (E), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/2" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the City and State Names - Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16" x 20" rectangles.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 4). **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".** Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.

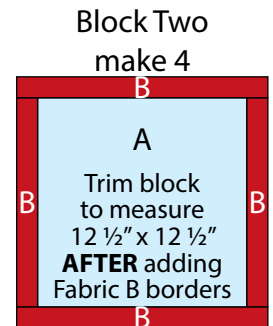

- Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 6).

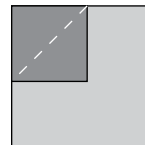

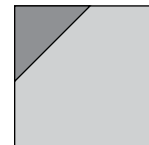

- Follow Figure 7 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric E square to each of the remaining corners of the 4 1/2" Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 8).

- Repeat Steps 10-11 to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.

- Repeat Steps 10-11 and refer to Figure 9 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Unit 2 squares.

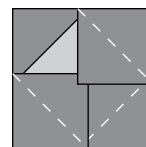

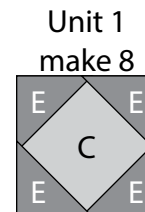

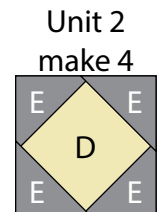

14. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of (1) Block Two square to make (1) Place Mat top. Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

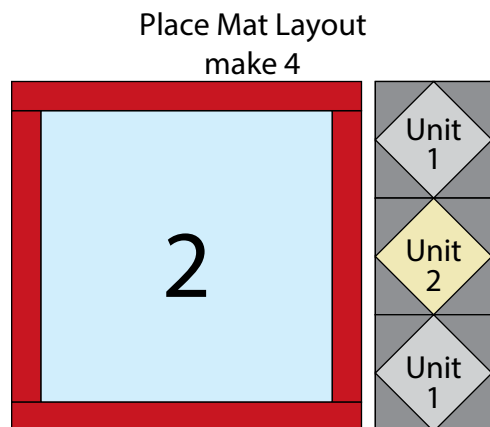

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
