

## Materials

*Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.*

1 panel 2247P-11 Floral Panel - Lt. Blue  
1/3 yard 2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue  
1/3 yard 2240-22 Butterfly Scroll - Pink  
3/8 yard 2246-77 Scrolly Flower - Blue  
5/8 yard 6383 Starlet - White  
5/8 yard 6383 Starlet - Royal  
1 yard 2238-11 Flowers with Butterflies - Lt. Blue  
3-5/8 yards 2244-22 Butterflies - Pink for backing  
64" x 64" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting

## Cut Fabrics

*Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.*

### From 2247P-11 Floral Panel - Lt. Blue:

\*Trim panel to 33" x 33".

### From 2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue:

\*Cut four 2" x WOF strips for border 3.

### From 2240-22 Butterfly Scroll - Pink:

\*Cut four 2" x WOF strips for border 1.

### From 2246-77 Scrolly Flower - Blue:

\*Cut five 2" x WOF strips for border 5.

### From 6383 Starlet - White:

\*Cut fourteen 1-1/4" x WOF strips for borders 2, 4, and 6.

### From 6383 Starlet - Royal:

\*Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

### From 2238-11 Flowers with Butterflies - Lt. Blue:

\*Cut six 5" x WOF strips for border 7.

## Assemble Quilt Top

1. For border 1, trim two 2" 2240-22 Butterfly Scroll - Pink strips to 33" length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the

border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

2. For border 2, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and trim two 1-1/4" 6383 Starlet - White strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

3. Repeat Step 2 with the four 2" 2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue strips to add border 3.

4. Repeat Step 2 with five 1-1/4" 6383 Starlet - White strips to add border 4.

5. For border 5, join the five 2" 2246-77 Scrolly Flower - Blue strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

6. Repeat Step 5 with the remaining 1-1/4" 6383 Starlet - White strips to make and add border 6.

7. Repeat Step 5 with the six 5" 2238-11 Flowers with Butterflies - Lt. Blue strips to make and add border 7.

## Finishing


8. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

9. Join the six 2-1/2" 6383 Starlet – Royal binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
