

Sunrise Garden - Quilt 2

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1/4 yard 2244-22 Butterflies - Pink

3/8 yard 2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue

3/8 yard 2241-70 Small Butterflies & Flower

Heads - Aqua

3/8 yard 2243-22 Floral - Pink

3/8 yard 2245-11 Small Floral with Butterflies -

Lt. Blue

1/2 yard 6383 Starlet - Petal

5/8 yard 2240-22 Butterfly Scroll - Pink

5/8 yard 2246-77 Scrolly Flower - Blue

3/4 yard 6383 Starlet - Royal

3/4 yard 2238-11 Flowers with Butterflies -

Lt. Blue

1-3/8 yards 6383 Starlet - White

3-1/2 yards 2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue

for backing

61" x 70" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100%

Cotton batting

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 2244-22 Butterflies – Pink:

*Cut one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut six 5-1/2" squares.

From each:

2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue 2241-70 Small Butterflies & Flower Heads - Aqua 2245-11 Small Floral with Butterflies - Lt. Blue *Cut two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eight 5-1/2" squares.

From 2243-22 Floral - Pink:

*Cut two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut ten 5-1/2" squares.

From 6383 Starlet - Petal:

*Cut two 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut ten 4-1/4" squares.

*Cut five 1-1/4" x WOF strips for border 2.

From each:

2240-22 Butterfly Scroll – Pink 2246-77 Scrolly Flower – Blue

*Cut three 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty 5-1/2" squares.

From 6383 Starlet – Royal:

*Cut two 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut ten 4-1/4" squares.

*Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 2238-11 Flowers with Butterflies - Lt. Blue:

*Cut six 4" x WOF strips for border 3.

From 6383 Starlet – White:

*Cut five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eighty 2-1/2" squares; cut once diagonally. (A) *Cut seven 3-3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eighty

3-3/8" squares.

*Cut five 2" x WOF strips for border 1.

Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.

Directions are for Blocks 1.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3-3/8" 6383 Starlet – White squares. With right sides together, place one marked White square on a corner of one 5-1/2" 2239-11 Paisley Lace - Lt. Blue square and stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to ½" and press open. Repeat with the other Lt. Blue squares (figure 1). Make eight 5-1/2" units. Save two units for Block 9.




Table 1. Block quantity and fabric combinations.




Figure 2 – Make (80) 1-3/4" units.

2. Mark two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 4-1/4" 6383 Starlet - Petal squares (a). Layer a marked Petal square atop a 4-1/4" 6383 Starlet - Royal square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the marked lines (b), cut vertically and horizontally to make four equal squares (c), then cut each square on the drawn lines to make eight half-square triangles (d). Press open and trim dog ears (*figure 2*, *here and next page*). Repeat with the remaining Petal and Royal squares to make a total of eighty 1-3/4" half-square triangles (HST).

3. Sew a 6383 Starlet – White triangle A to one side of the Step 2 units. Press open. Sew another triangle A to the adjacent side of the same units. Press open and trim ears (*figure 3*). On the **wrong side** of each patch, measure 1/4" from the wide edge and draw a line.



4. Measure 2-1/2" down from the top right corner of the Step 1 units and mark the spot with a short line. Measure 2-1/2" from the left bottom corner of the same units toward the right bottom corner and mark it with another short line. Following the Step 4 diagram *next page:* with the right sides together, align the 1/4" line of a Step 3 patch with the marks you just made on the Step 1 units. Pin and stitch. Trim the unit as shown, press open and trim ears (*figure 4*). Repeat with all the units. Save remaining Step 3 patches for the other blocks.



5. Repeat Step 1 with the 5-1/2" 2246-77 Scrolly Flower – Blue squares and the 3-3/8" 6383 Starlet – White squares, and Step 4 using the Step 3 patches (*figure 5*).




Figure 6 – Make (3) 10-1/2" blocks.

6. Noting fabric orientation, sew together one Step 4 unit with one Step 5 unit and press the seams open. Repeat to make six strips. Join two strips to make a block and press the seams open (*figure 6*). Repeat to make three 10-1/2" blocks.

7. Repeat Steps 1, 4, and 6 to make the remaining 5-1/2" squares of assorted colors, referring to Table 1 for the fabric combinations. Make seventeen more 10-1/2" blocks for a total of twenty.

Assemble Quilt Top

8. Following the quilt photo for block placement and orientation, lay out five rows of four blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row, then matching adjacent seams sew the rows together in order.



- 9. For border 1, join the five 2" 6383 Starlet White strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 10. Repeat Step 9 with the five 1-1/4" 6383 Starlet Petal strips to make and add border 2.
- 11. Repeat Step 9 with the six 4" 2238-11 Flowers with Butterflies Lt. Blue strips to make and add border 3.

Finishing

- 12. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
- 13. Join the six 2-1/2" 6383 Starlet Royal binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
