



#### Pillowcase #1 Materials

1 yard	Superhero Blocks - Blue (A)	1606-77
1/8 yard	Stars - Black (B)	1611-99
⅓ yard	Starlet - Red (C)	6383-Red

#### Pillowcase #2 Materials

1 yard	Superhero Words - Black (A)	1613-99
1/8 yard	Superhero Masks - Black (B)	1607-99
1/3 yard	Starlet - Yellow (C)	6383-Yellow

#### **Pillowcase #1 Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Superhero Blocks - Blue (A), cut:

• (1) 30 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle.

#### From the Stars - Black (B), cut:

• (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" strip.

#### From the Starlet - Red (C), cut:

• (1) 10 ½" x 40 ½" strip.

#### **Pillowcase #2 Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Superhero Words - Black (A), cut:

• (1) 30 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle.

#### From the Superhero Masks - Black (B), cut:

• (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip.

#### From the Starlet - Yellow (C), cut:

• (1) 10 ½" x 40 ½" strip.


#### **Pillow Case Assembly:**

- 1. Fold (1) 1 1/4" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and press.
- 2. Place the Folded Fabric B strip along the long side of (1) 30 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A rectangle, aligning the raw edges and pin in place. Make sure the right side of the Fabric A rectangle is facing up (Fig. 1).

- 3. Fold (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and press.
- 4. Place the Folded Fabric C strip on top of the Fabric B/Fabric A pieces, aligning the raw edges and pin in place (Fig. 2).
- 5. Stitch across the top of the layered fabrics using a ¼" seam allowance to make the pillowcase body (Fig. 3).









6. Fold the pillowcase body in half width wise, aligning the raw edges of the Fabric A, Fabric B and Fabric C pieces. Pin in place. Stitch down the long side and across the bottom of the folded pillowcase body (Fig. 4).



- 7. Turn the pillowcase right side out and press to make (1) Pillowcase #1 (Fig. 5).
- 8. Repeat Steps 1-6 and refer to Figure 6 or fabric identification and placement to make (1) Pillowcase #2 (Fig. 6).




