

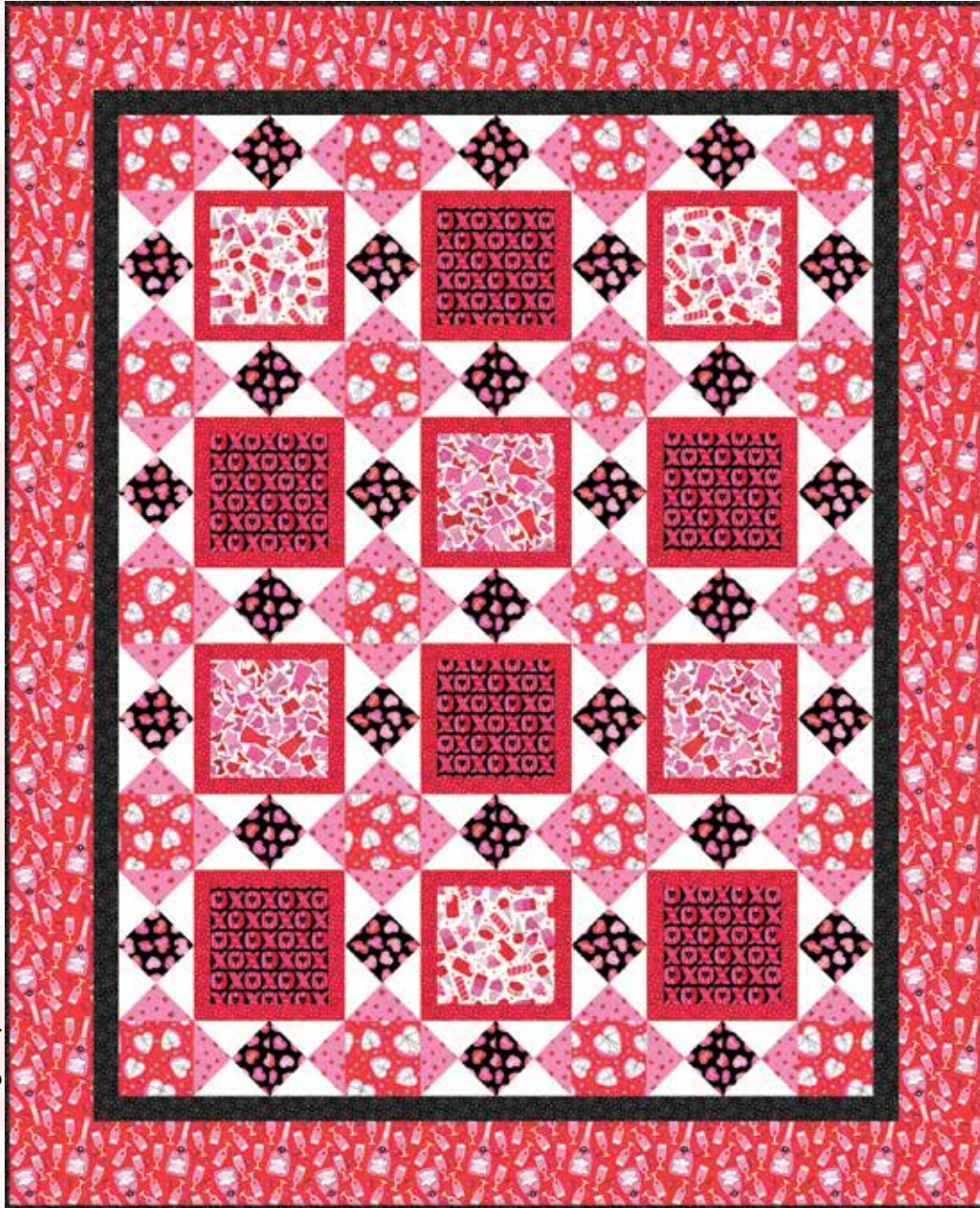

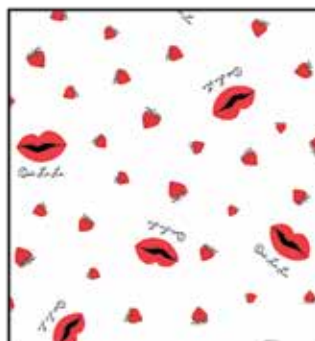

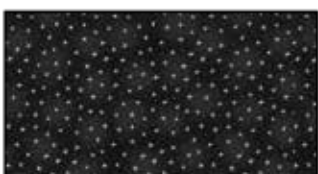

5/8 yard	Starlet - Red (B)	6383-Red
1/3 yard	Lingerie - Pink (C)	2504-22
1/2 yard	XOXO - Black (D)	2506-99
5/8 yard	Hearts Candy - Black (E)	2498-99
5/8 yard	Strawberries - Pink (F)	2503-22
7/8 yard	Starlet - White (G)	6383-White
1/2 yard	Valentine's Day Hearts - Red (H)	2502-88
1 yard	Starlet - Black (I)	6383-Black*
1 7/8 yards	Champagne Bottles & Glasses - Red (J)	2500-88
4 1/2 yards	Words & Champagne - White (Backing)	2499-01

*Includes binding

Batting: 66" x 80"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Ice Cream - White (A), cut:

- (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 7 1/2" squares.

From the Starlet - Red (B), cut:

- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.

From the Lingerie - Pink (C), cut:

- (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 7 1/2" squares.

From the XOXO - Black (D), cut:

- (2) 7 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 7 1/2" squares.

From the Hearts Candy - Black (E), cut:

- (3) 5 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 3/8" triangles.
- Note: You will use (62) 5 3/8" triangles.*

From the Strawberries - Pink (F), cut:

- (3) 5 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 3/8" triangles.
- Note: You will use (62) 5 3/8" triangles.*

From the Starlet - White (G), cut:

- (5) 5 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 5 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (124) 5 3/8" triangles.

From the Valentine's Day Hearts - Red (H), cut:

- (3) 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 5" squares.

From the Starlet - Black (I), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 59" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Champagne Bottles & Glasses - Red (J), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 62" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 1/2" x 58 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Words & Champagne - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 80" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 80" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) 9 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (3) Block One squares total.

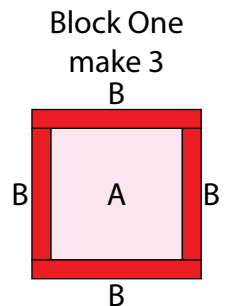

2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) 9 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

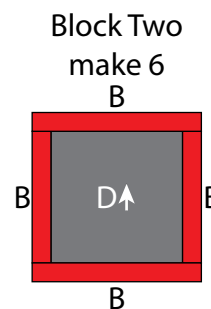

3. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) 9 1/2" Block Three square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (3) Block Three squares total.

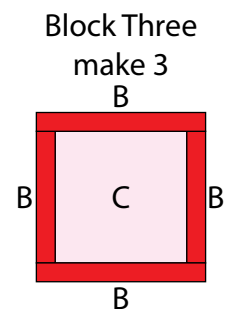
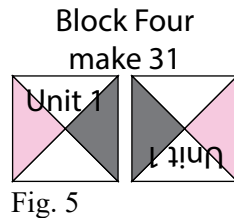
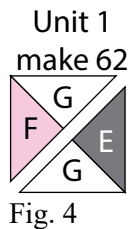

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (1) 5 3/8" Fabric F triangle, (2) 5 3/8" Fabric G triangles and (1) 5 3/8" Fabric E triangle to make (1) 5" Unit 1 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (62) Unit 1 squares total.



5. Sew together (2) Unit 1 squares as shown in Figure 5 to make (1) 5" x 9 1/2" Block Four rectangle. Repeat to make (31) Block Four rectangles total.

6. Sew together (4) 5" Fabric H squares and (3) Block Four rectangles, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 6). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.

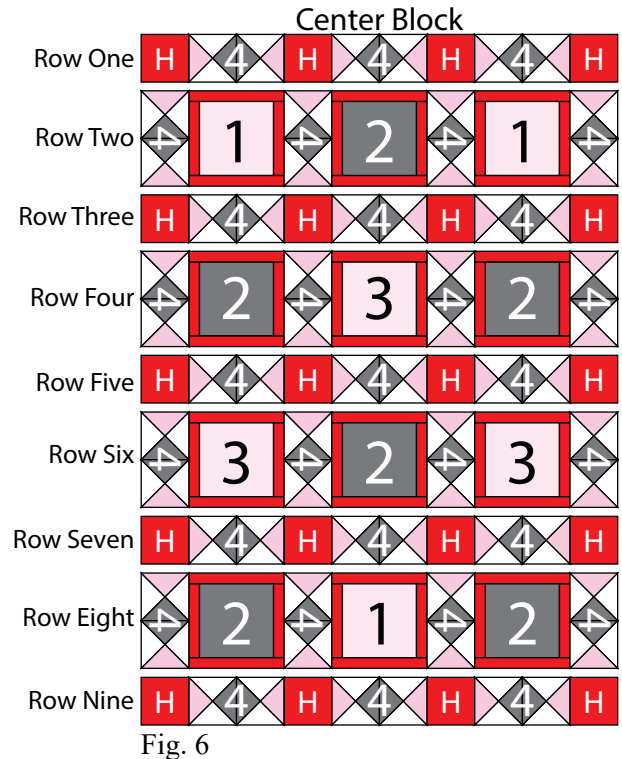
7. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Four rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 6).

8. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Four rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four (Fig. 6).

9. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Six (Fig. 6).

10. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Four rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Eight (Fig. 6).

11. Sew together the (9) Rows from Steps 6-10, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 45 1/2" x 59" Center Block (Fig. 6).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

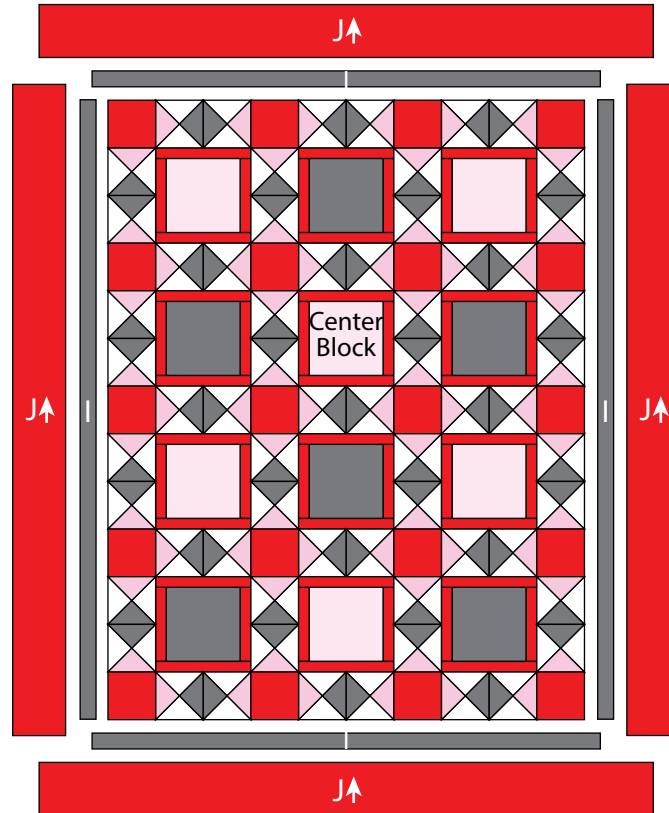
12. Sew (1) 2" x 59" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 48 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 62" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 58 1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
