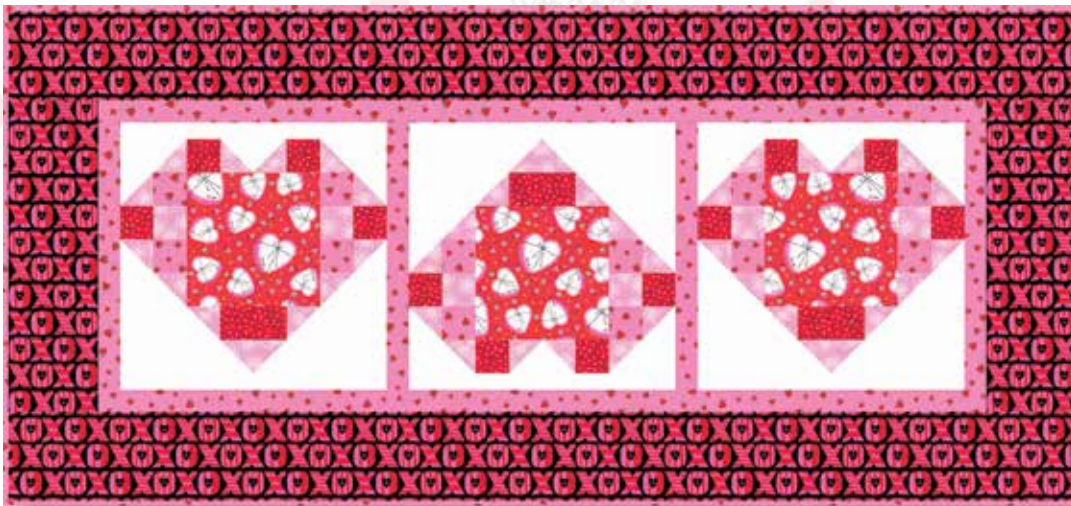

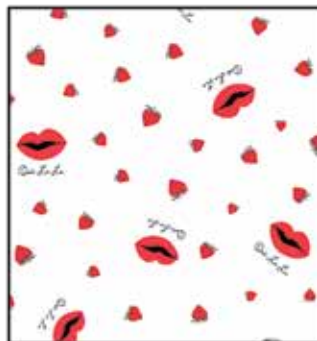

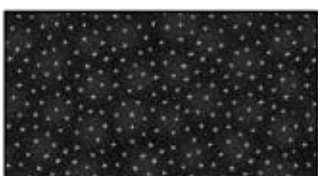

¼ yard	Valentine's Day Hearts - Red (A)	2502-88
⅛ yard	Starlet - Red (B)	6383-Red
¼ yard	Starlet - Petal (C)	6383-Petal
⅝ yard	Strawberries - Pink (D)	2503-22*
½ yard	Starlet - White (E)	6383-White
⅔ yard	XOXO - Black (F)	2506-99
1 ⅔ yards	Words & Champagne - White (Backing)	2499-01

Batting: 56" x 30"

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Valentine's Day Hearts - Red (A), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Red (B), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (18) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Petal (C), cut:

- (2) 2 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (21) 2 ⅜" squares and (6) 2" squares.

From the Strawberries - Pink (D), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starlet - White (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (21) 2 ⅜" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (18) 2" squares.
- (2) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 1 ¼" x 12 ½" strips.

From the XOXO - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 48 ½" strips.

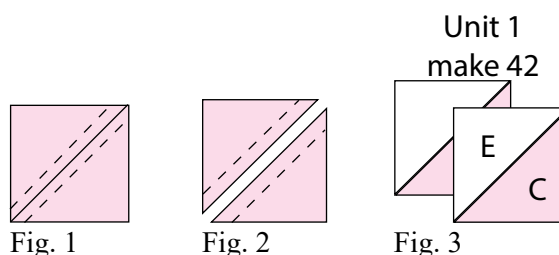
From the Words & Champagne - White (Backing), cut:

- (1) 56" x 30" WOF strip for the backing.

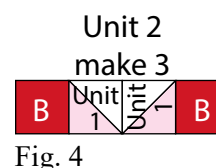
Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

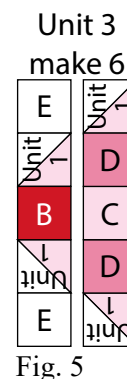
1. Place (1) 2 ⅜" Fabric C square on top of (1) 2 ⅜" Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (42) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew together (1) 2" Fabric B square, (2) Unit 1 squares and (1) 2" Fabric B square, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (3) Unit 2 strips total.



3. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (2) 2" Fabric E squares, (4) Unit 1 squares, (1) 2" Fabric B square, (2) 2" Fabric D squares and (1) 2" Fabric C square into a 2 x 5 matrix to make (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 strips total.



4. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (2) 2" Fabric B squares and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row. Sew together (1) 2" Fabric E square, (2) Unit 1 squares and (1) 2" Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (3) Unit 4 strips total.

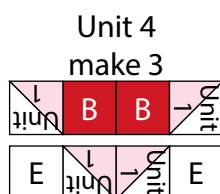

5. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the left and right sides of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (3) Unit 5 strips total.

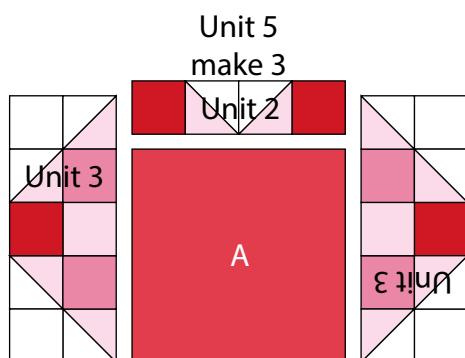

6. Sew (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the top of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (3) Unit 6 rectangles total.

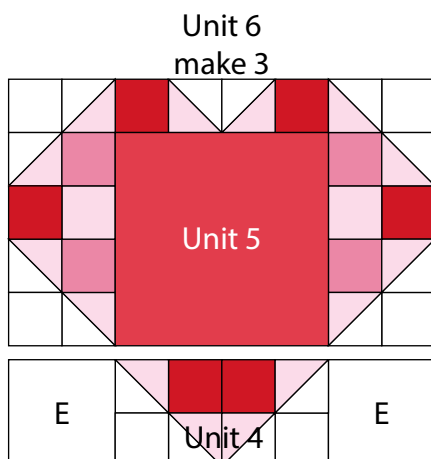

7. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 6 rectangle to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (3) Block One squares total.

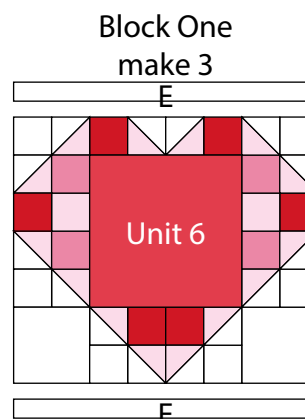

8. Sew together the (3) Block One squares and (2) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strips, alternating them from left to right, to make the 38 1/2" x 12 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 10).

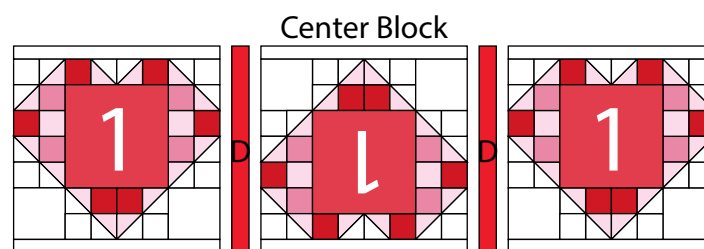

Runner Top Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 11 while assembling the runner top.)

9. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Runner top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.

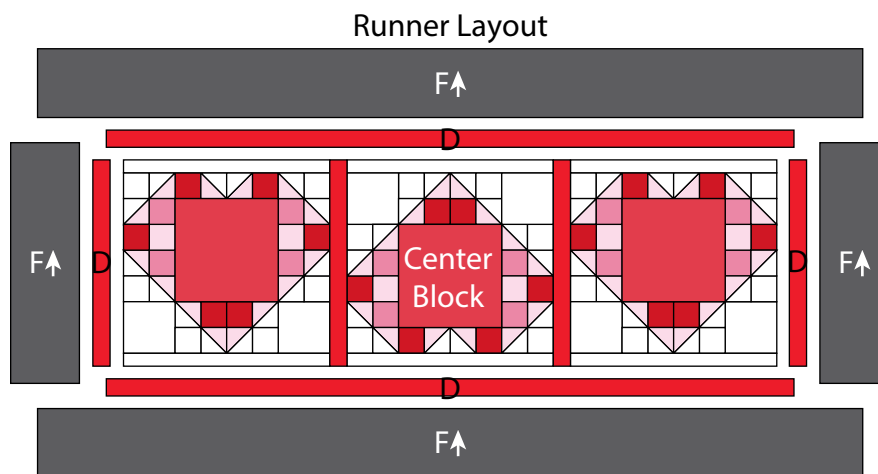

¾ yard	Starlet - Red (B)	6383-Red*
¼ yard	Starlet - Petal (C)	6383-Petal
⅛ yard	Strawberries - Pink (D)	2503-22
¾ yard	Starlet - White (E)	6383-White
½ yard	Hearts Candy - Black (F)	2498-99
1 ⅛ yards	Ice Cream - White (Backs)	2501-01

Batting: (4) 21" x 18"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Champagne Bottles & Glasses - Red (A), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starlet - Petal (C), cut:

- (2) 2 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ⅜" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" squares.

From the Strawberries - Pink (D), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - White (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ⅜" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 11" strips.
- (4) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ¼" x 14 ½" strips.

From the Hearts Candy - Black (F), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 12 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 17 ½" strips.

From the Ice Cream - White (Backs), cut:

- (2) 21" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 21" x 18" rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

14. Place (1) 2 ⅜" Fabric C square on top of (1) 2 ⅜" Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 12). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 12). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" square to make (2) Unit 7 squares (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (56) Unit 7 squares total.

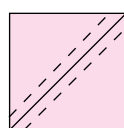

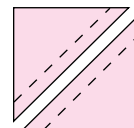

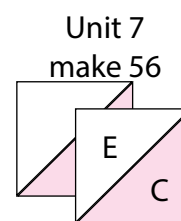

15. Sew together (1) 2" Fabric B square, (2) Unit 7 squares and (1) 2" Fabric B square, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Unit 8 strips total.



16. Follow Figure 16 and sew together (2) 2" Fabric E squares, (4) Unit 7 squares, (1) 2" Fabric B square, (2) 2" Fabric D squares and (1) 2" Fabric C square into a 2 x 5 matrix to make (1) Unit 9 strip. Repeat to make (8) Unit 9 strips total.

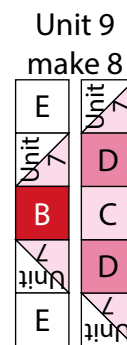

17. Sew together (1) Unit 7 square, (2) 2" Fabric B squares and (1) Unit 7 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row. Sew together (1) 2" Fabric E square, (2) Unit 7 squares and (1) 2" Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 strips total.

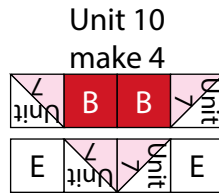

18. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the top of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to the left and right sides of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 strips total.

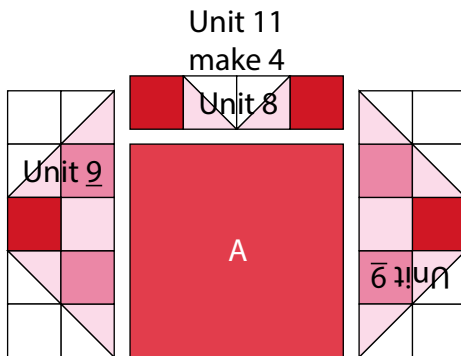

19. Sew (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 10 strip. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to the top of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (4) Block Two rectangles total.

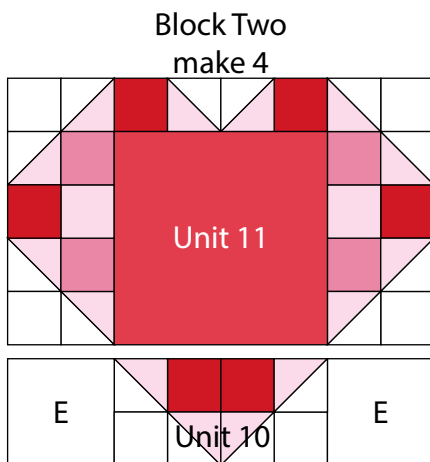

Place Mat Top Assembly

(Follow the Place Mat Layout in Figure 20 while assembling the place mat tops.)

20. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 11" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Block Two rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 14 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Two rectangle.

21. Sew (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Block Two rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 17 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two rectangle to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 20).

22. Repeat Steps 20-21 to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

23. Layer and quilt as desired.

24. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.

25. Bind as desired.

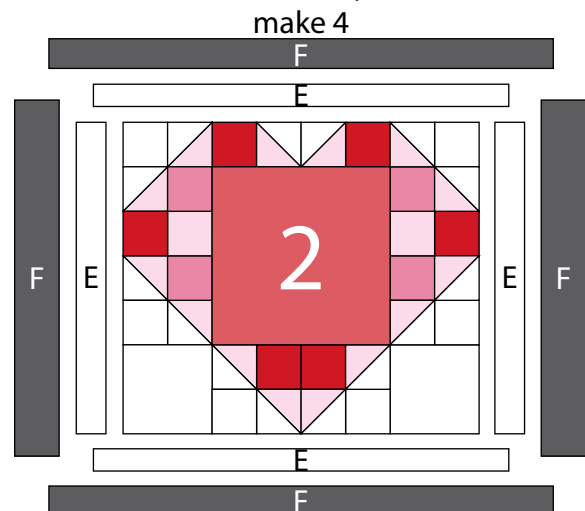
