#### **Cutting Instructions - Quilt**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Dinosaur Fight Panel - Gray (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 42 ½" x 22 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Urban Legend - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 22 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 ½" strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" x 10" strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" x 9 \(^3\)4" strips.

#### From the Urban Legend - Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 8 ½" strips.
- (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 62 ½" strips.
- (7) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 3" x 67 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 19 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Dinosaur Blocks - Black (D):

• Fussy cut (16) 6 3/4" x 10" rectangles, each centered on a block.

#### From the Trex Collage - Gray (E), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 7" squares.

#### From the Urban Legend - Olive (F), cut:

- (6) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 1/4" x 7" strips.
- (8) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Tossed Dinosaurs - Black (G), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7" squares.
- (4) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (4) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ½" x 79 ½" strips.

#### From the Flying Pteranodons - Blue (H), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 7" squares.

#### From the Urban Legend - Chocolate (I), cut:

• (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Dinosaur Patch - Green (Backing), cut:

• (3) 87" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 87" x 92" back.

#### **Cutting Instructions - Body Pillow**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Dinosaur Blocks - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 20 ½" x 72 ½" strip (3 Blocks x 7 Blocks), centered on the blocks.

#### From the Urban Legend - Black (B), cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 72 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Urban Legend - Black (Backing), cut:

• (1) 74 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 24 ½" x 74 ½" strip.

#### **Cutting Instructions - Gaming Pillow**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Dinosaur Blocks - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 41 ½" x 30 ¾" strip (3 Blocks x 6 Blocks), centered on the blocks.

#### From the Urban Legend - Black (B), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 3" x 30 3/4" WOF strips.

#### From the Urban Legend - Black (Backing), cut:


• (1) 45 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 45 ½" x 34 ¾" strip.

#### **Block Assembly**


Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 22 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 42 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 45 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 44 ½" x 24 ½".




2. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1)

6 3/4" x 10" Fabric D rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 9 3/4" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 2). Trim the unit to measure 8 ½" x 11 ½". Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 rectangles total.




- 3. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 7" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.
- 4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 4-5 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make (4) Unit 3 squares and (6) Unit 4 squares.




- 5. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the top of (1) Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (3) Unit 5 strips total.
- 6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 7-11 for component identification and location to make (2) Unit 6 strips, (4) Unit 7 strips, (3) Unit 8 strips, (2) Unit 9 strips and (2) Unit 10 strips.

7. Follow Figure 12 and sew together (2) Unit 5 strips, (6) 1 ½" x 19 ½" Fabric C strips, (2) Unit 9 strips, (2) Unit 7 strips and (1) Unit 8 strip to make (1) Unit 11 strip.



8. Follow Figure 13 and sew together (2) Unit 8 strips, (6) 1 ½" x 19 ½" Fabric C strips, (2) Unit 6 strips, (2) Unit 10 strips and (1) Unit 5 strip to make (1) Unit 12 strip.




9. Sew (1) 3" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 7 strip to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make a second Unit 13 strip.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) Unit 13 strip to each side of the Center Block.

- 12. Sew (1) 3" x 62 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew the Unit 11 strip to the top of the Center Block and the Unit 12 strip to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 3" x 67 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 67 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 72 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 79 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (9) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.






**Body Pillow Assembly** 

Note: Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


- 19. Sew (1) 3" x 72 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 ½" x 72 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 2" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 74 ½" to make the Body Pillow top.
- 20. Place the Body Pillow top and backing right sides together and pin.
- 21. Sew the Body Pillow top and backing together, leaving an opening for turning.
- 22. Turn the pillow right sides out.
- 23. Add fiber fill and sew the opening closed to complete the Body Pillow.



#### **Gaming Pillow Assembly**

Note: Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 24. Sew (1) 3" x 30 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of the 41 ½" x 30 ¾" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 3" x 46 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip. Trim the block to measure 45 ½" x 34 ¾" to make the Gaming Pillow top.
- 25. Place the Gaming Pillow top and backing right sides together and pin.
- 26. Sew the Gaming Pillow top and backing together, leaving an opening for turning.
- 27. Turn the pillow right sides out.
- 28. Add fiber fill and sew the opening closed to complete the Gaming Pillow.
