Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Farm Panel - Green (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" panel.

From the Texture - Dark Teal (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 7" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (12) Template 1 Hexagons.

From the Windmills - Blue (C), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 30½ WOF strips.

From the Cow Collage - Dark Teal (D), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7" squares.

From the Urban Legend - White (E), cut:

- (3) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 8 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) 8 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.

From the Clothesline - Blue (F), cut:

• (4) Template 2 Hexagons.

From the Texture - Pink (G), cut:

- (8) Template 1 Hexagons.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Farm Scenic - Blue (H), cut:

• (4) Template 3 Hexagons.

From the Animal Hexagon - Mint (I), cut:

• (4) Template 2 Hexagons.

From the Allover Floral - Pink (J), cut:

• (4) Template 3 Hexagons.

From the Texture - Green (K), cut:


- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 68 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.

From the Rooster - White (Backing), cut:


• (2) 79" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 59" x 79" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 2" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).




2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.



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- 3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 4. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 5. Refer to Figure 3 to arrange and press the (6) Template 1 hexagons, (2) Template 2 hexagons and (3) Template 3 hexagons onto (1) 8 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric E strip.
- 6. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the Left Side Border.
- 7. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figure 4 for component identification and location to make the Right Side Border.



- 8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figure 5 below to arrange and press the (4) Template 1 hexagons, (2) Template 2 hexagons and (1) Template 3 hexagon onto (1) 8 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of the Fabric E strip to make the Top Border.
- 9. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figure 6 below to arrange and press the (4) Template 1 hexagons, (2) Template 2 hexagons and (1) Template 3 hexagon onto (1) 8 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of the Fabric E strip to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew the Left Side Border and the Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 2" x 68 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 15. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.








