2/3 yard Farm Blocks - Blue (A) 9875-70
$1 / 2$ yard Urban Legend - White (B) 7101-01
$3 / 8$ yard Texture - Green (C)
$1 / 4$ yard Allover Floral - Pink (D) 9880-22
$1 / 2$ yard Windmills - Blue (E) 9879-70
$3 / 8$ yard Texture - Dark Teal (F) 9884-76*
$11 / 4$ yards Cow Collage - Dark Teal (Backing) 9878-76

## Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Farm Blocks - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (4) $91 / 2$ " squares each centered on a block.

From the Urban Legend - White (B), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 " \times 25$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 4 \times 261 / 2 "$ WOF strips.


## From the Texture - Green (C), cut:

- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3 " square and (8) $13 / 4 " x 3 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 23$ " WOF strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{112 "}{2 \prime} \times 25$ " WOF strips.
From the Allover Floral - Pink (D), cut:
- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 " squares.

From the Windmills - Blue (E), cut:

- (4) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 26^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.

From the Texture - Dark Teal (F), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Cow Collage - Dark Teal (Backing), cut:

- (1) 40 " square for the back.

Table Topper Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $91 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 11 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the $91 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure $101 / 2$ " square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares.

2. Sew together (3) 3" Fabric D squares and make 4
(2) $13 / 4 " \times 3 "$ Fabric C strips, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.

3. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).

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Table Topper Assembly
(Follow the Topper Layout while assembling the table topper top.)
4. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 23$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 25$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 25 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 4$ " $\times 26^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 261 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square to each end of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 26^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the top.
7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.

## Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Farm Blocks - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (4) $91 / 2 "$ squares each centered on a block.


## From the Urban Legend - White (B), cut:

-(2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

## From the Texture - Pink (C), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 "$ x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

From the Allover Floral - Pink (D), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Windmills - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $37 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Chickens - White (F), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Texture - Dark Teal (G), cut:

-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

## From the Rooster - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 22 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16 " $\times 22$ " strips for the backs.


## Place Mat Block Assembly

10. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of
(1) $91 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew
(1) $11 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure $101 / 2$ " square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

11. Sew (1) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.

12. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 3 square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8).

13. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 10).
14. Repeat Steps 12-13 to make (4) Block Two squares total.

15. Place (1) $37 / 8 "$ Fabric D square on top of (1) $37 / 8 "$ Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 11). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 11). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 12) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $31 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (16) Unit 4 squares total.

Note: The arrows in Figure 17 and 18 represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the orientation of the fabric when assembling Unit 5 and Unit 6.
16. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 14). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ${ }^{1 / 4}$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 15).

17. Place another $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square on the right side of the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 16). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 16). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 17).
18. Repeat Steps 16-17 to make (4) Unit 5 strips total.

19. Repeat Steps 16-17 and refer to Figure 18 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Unit 6 strips.

## Place Mat Top Assembly (Follow the Place Mat Layout in Figure 19 while assembling the place mats. Also, pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the place mat tops.)

20. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the top and bottom of (1) Unit 5 strip. Sew the new strip to the left side of (1) Block Two square.
21. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the top and bottom of (1) Unit 6 strip. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Block Two square from Step 11 to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 19).
22. Repeat Steps 20-21 to make (4) Place mat tops total.
23. Layer and quilt as desired.
24. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
25. Bind as desired.
