$11 / 8$ yards Periwinkle Blossoms - Purple (B) 2436-75
$11 / 4$ yards Jot Dot - Dark Blue (C)
$1 / 4 / 4$ yards Tonal Leave Texture - Powder Blue (D) 2434-11*
$1 / 2$ yard Tonal Butterfly Floral - Violet (E) 2433-25
7/8 yard Chameleon - Ivory (F) 1178-41
$15 / 8$ yards Botanical Patchwork - Powder Blue (G) 2438-11
5 yards Butterfly and Floral Stamp - Teal (Backing)
2435-76
*Includes binding
Batting: 70" x 85 "

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Large Butterfly - Periwinkle (A), cut:
-(2) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Periwinkle Blossoms - Purple (B), cut:

- (7) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 3 " squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 621 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 501 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Jot Dot - Dark Blue (C), cut:

- (7) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tonal Leave Texture - Powder Blue (D), cut:

- (14) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (192) 3 " squares.
- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Tonal Butterfly Floral - Violet (E), cut:

- (4) $33 / 8 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $33 / 8 "$ squares.


## From the Chameleon - Ivory ( $\mathbf{F}$ ), cut:

- (4) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $33 / 8$ " squares.
-(3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Botanical Patchwork - Powder Blue (G), cut:

- (4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 651 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Butterfly and Floral Stamp - Teal (Backing), cut:

- (2) 85 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70 " x 85 " back.

Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 3 " Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2).

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric D square to the upper right corner and 3" Fabric B squares to the lower left and lower right corners of the $51 / 2$ " Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (48) Unit 1 squares total.

4. Place (1) $33 / 8 "$ Fabric E square on top of (1) $33 / 8$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 5). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 " square to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (96) Unit 2 squares total.

5. Sew (1) 3 " Fabric D square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $51 / 2 "$ Unit 3 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (48) Unit 3 squares total.

6. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) $5^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $151 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

7. Sew (3) Block One squares together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.
8. Sew together the (4) Rows from Step 7, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $451 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 10).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 9. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 471 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 621 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $501 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 651 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 621 / 2$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
