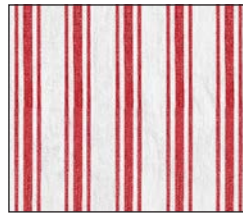

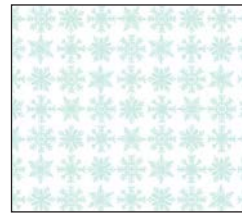

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Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1 panel 2306P-60 Winter Panel - Mint
1/3 yard 2298-88 Ticking Stripe - Red
1/3 yard 7101-66 Urban Legend - Hunter
2/3 yard 2299-60 Snowflakes - Mint
3/4 yard 7101-88 Urban Legend - Red
3/4 yard 2296-60 Cardinals & Chickadees in Tree - Mint
2-7/8 yards 2301-01 Scenic Snowman - White for backing
48" x 68" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting
Fusible web

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 2306P-60 Winter Panel – Mint:

*Trim panel to 19-1/2" x 39-1/2".

From 2298-88 Ticking Stripe – Red:

*Cut four 2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 7101-66 Urban Legend – Hunter:

*Cut three 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

*Cut twelve leaves using templates.

From 2299-60 Snowflakes – Mint:

*Cut one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 2-1/2" squares.

*Cut four 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty-six 2-7/8" squares.

*Cut four 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 4.

From 7101-88 Urban Legend – Red:

*Cut two 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut nine 5-1/4" squares.

*Cut five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

*Cut twelve circles using the template.

From 2296-60 Cardinals & Chickadees in Tree – Mint:

*Cut five 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 5.

Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.

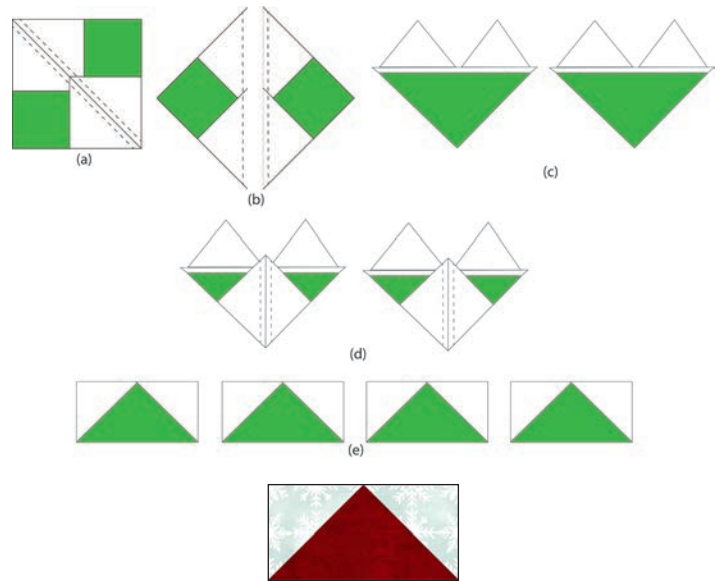


Figure 1 – Make (34) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" units.

1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2-7/8" 2299-60 Snowflakes – Mint squares. With right sides together, place two marked Mint squares on opposite corners of one 5-1/4" 7101-88 Urban Legend – Red square, making sure drawn lines intersect in the middle and noting that the corners of the small squares will overlap. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the marked line (a), cut on the drawn line (b), and press each unit open (c). Place one more marked Mint square on the corner of each unit, stitch as before (d), and cut. Press the seams open (e) to make four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" flying-geese units. Repeat with the remaining 2-7/8" Mint and the 4-1/4" Red squares to make a total of thirty-four flying-geese units (*figure 1*).

2. Place the leaf shapes onto a lightbox or window-pane. Layer the fusible web onto them and trace each one four times. Cut each shape 1/8" outside the outline and fuse to the wrong side of the 7101-66 Urban Legend – Hunter fabrics. Repeat with the circles and the 7101-88 Urban Legend – Red fabric. Cut on the outline and remove the paper backing.

Assemble Quilt Top

3. For border 1, join the 1-1/2" 7101-66 Urban Legend – Hunter border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Cut two 39-1/2" long strips and sew them to each side of the panel. Press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

4. For border 2, repeat Step 3 with the four 2" 2298-88 Ticking Stripe – Red, trimming the side strips to 41-1/2".

5. For border 3 and referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange eleven blocks for each side of the quilt. Sew blocks together and sew one border strip to each side of the quilt center. Press the seam toward quilt center.

6. Repeat Step 5 with six blocks and two 2-1/2" 2299-60 Snowflakes – Mint squares, and sew one border strip to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center.

7. For border 4, join the four 1-1/2" 2299-60 Snowflakes – Mint strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top

and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

8. Repeat Step 7 with the five 4-1/2" 2296-60 Cardinals & Chickadees in Tree – Mint strips to make and add border 5.

9. Position appliqué shapes on the corners of the quilt and fuse them according to the manufacturer's instructions. Machine appliqué using matching thread and the blanket stitch.

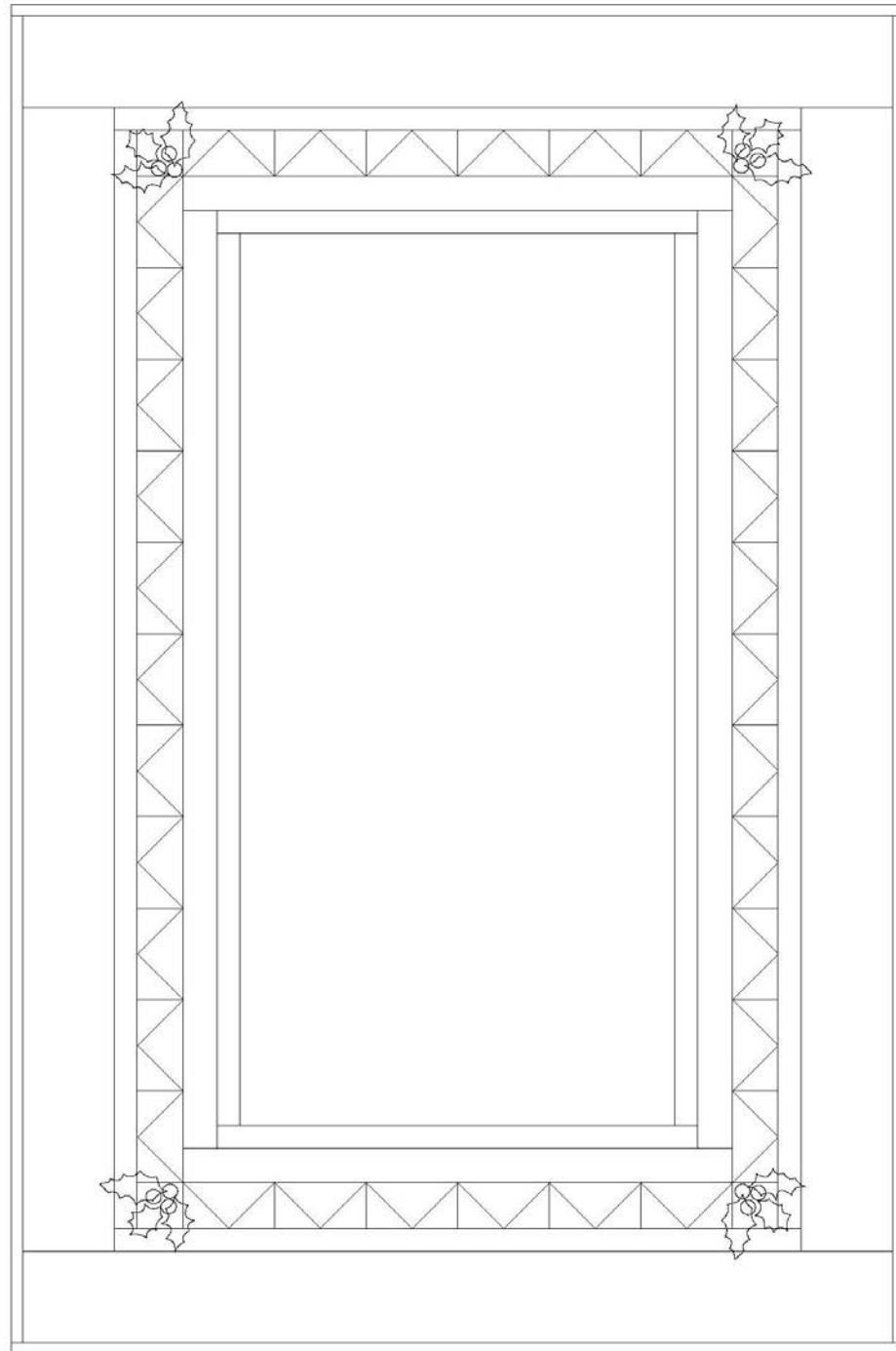
Finishing

10. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

11. Join the five 2-1/2" 7101-88 Urban Legend – Red binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.

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Quilt Diagram

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Templates are 100% Scale.
Trace each leaf 4 times on the
smooth side of the fusible web.
Trace the circle twelve times.
