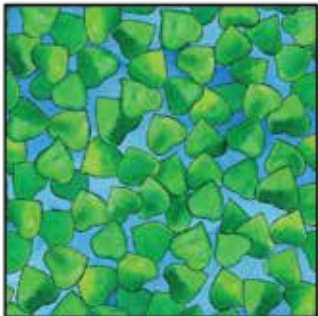

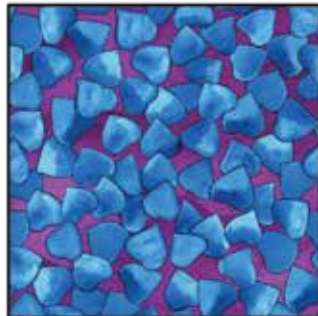

1 1/4 yards	Urban Legend - Dark Purple (B)	7101-55*
1/3 yard	Wolves - Gray (C)	1309-90
1/3 yard	Owls - Amber (D)	1310-30
2 3/4 yards	Jot Dot - Fog (E)	9570-93
1/2 yard	Allover Floral - Green (F)	1307-66
1 yard	Birds - Light Blue (G)	1311-70
2/3 yard	Bears in Trees - Dark Blue (H)	1308-77
1/2 yard	Leaves - Blue (I)	1312-75
2 1/8 yards	Animals with Leaves - Green (J)	1306-66
5 1/4 yards	Leaves - Green (Backing)	1312-66

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Animal Blocks - Dark Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (8) 9 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Urban Legend - Dark Purple (B), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Wolves - Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 1/2" squares.

From the Owls - Amber (D), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 1/2" squares.

From the Jot Dot - Fog (E), cut:

- (29) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (452) 2 1/2" squares.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Allover Floral - Green (F), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Birds - Light Blue (G), cut:

- (7) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (62) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Bears in Trees - Dark Blue (H), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Leaves - Blue (I), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 68 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 1/2" strips.

From the Animals with Leaves - Green (J), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x 71 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 1/2" x 67 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

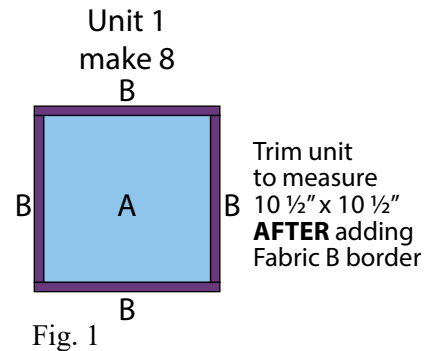
From the Leaves - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 91" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 75" x 91" back.

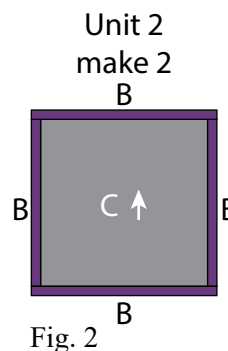
Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components.

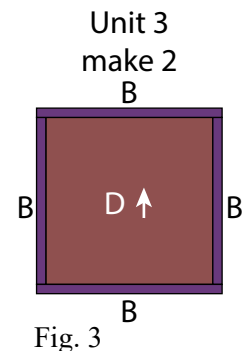
1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. **Trim the block to measure 10 1/2" square** to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.



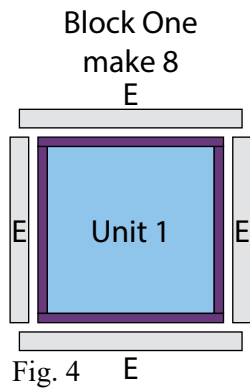
2. Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.



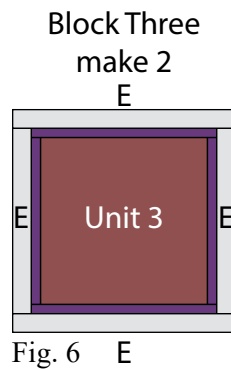
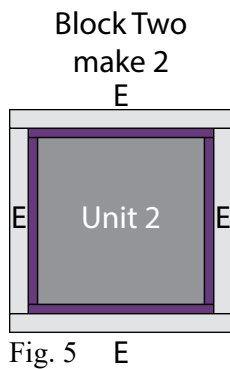
3. Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 square.



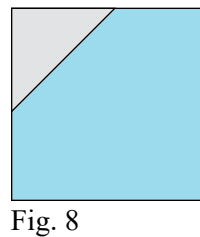
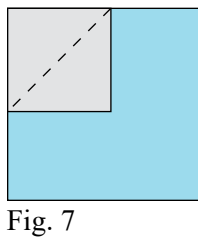
4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.



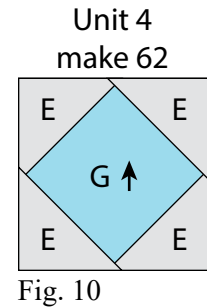
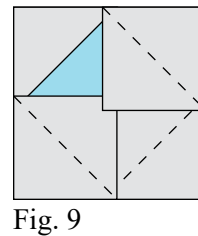
5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figures 5-6 for component identification and placement to make (2) Block Two squares and (2) Block Three squares.



6. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) 4 ½" Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

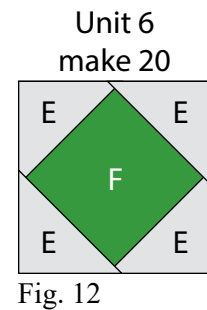
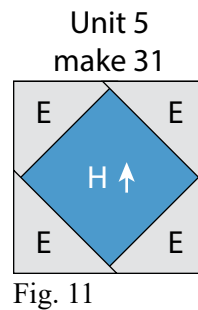


7. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric E square to each of the remaining corners of the 4 ½" Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 10).

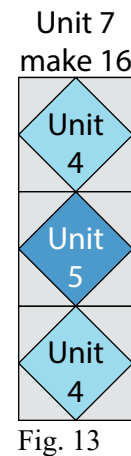


8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (62) Unit 4 squares total.

9. Repeat Steps 6-7 and refer to Figures 11-12 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (31) Unit 5 squares and (20) Unit 6 squares.



10. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 5 square to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (16) Unit 7 strips total.



11. Sew together (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Block Three square and (1) Unit 7 strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 8 strip.

12. Sew together (4) Unit 7 strips and (3) Block One squares, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Unit 9 strip.

13. Sew together (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) Unit 7 strip, in that order left to right, to make (1) Unit 10 strip.

14. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (15) Unit 11 strips total.

15. Sew together (4) Unit 6 squares and (3) Unit 11 strips, end to end and alternating them, to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (5) Unit 12 strips total.

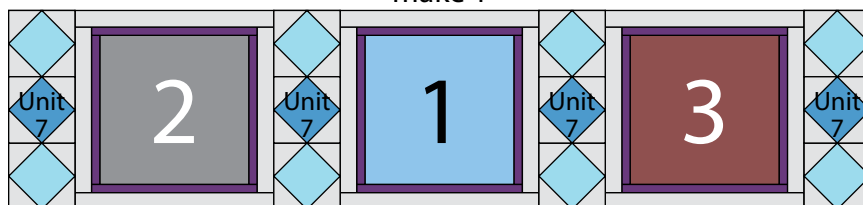

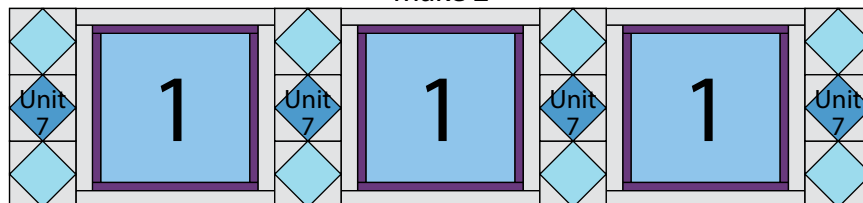

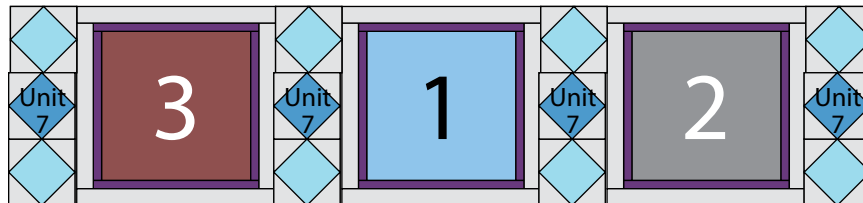

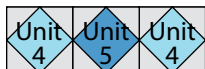

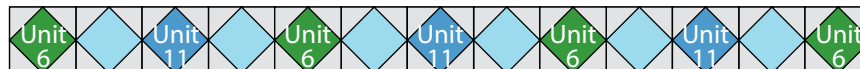

Quilt 2

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top. The arrows in the Quilt Layout represent the fabric print direction.)

16. Sew together (1) Unit 12 strip, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 12 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Unit 12 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Unit 12 strip, (1) Unit 10 strip and (1) Unit 12 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.

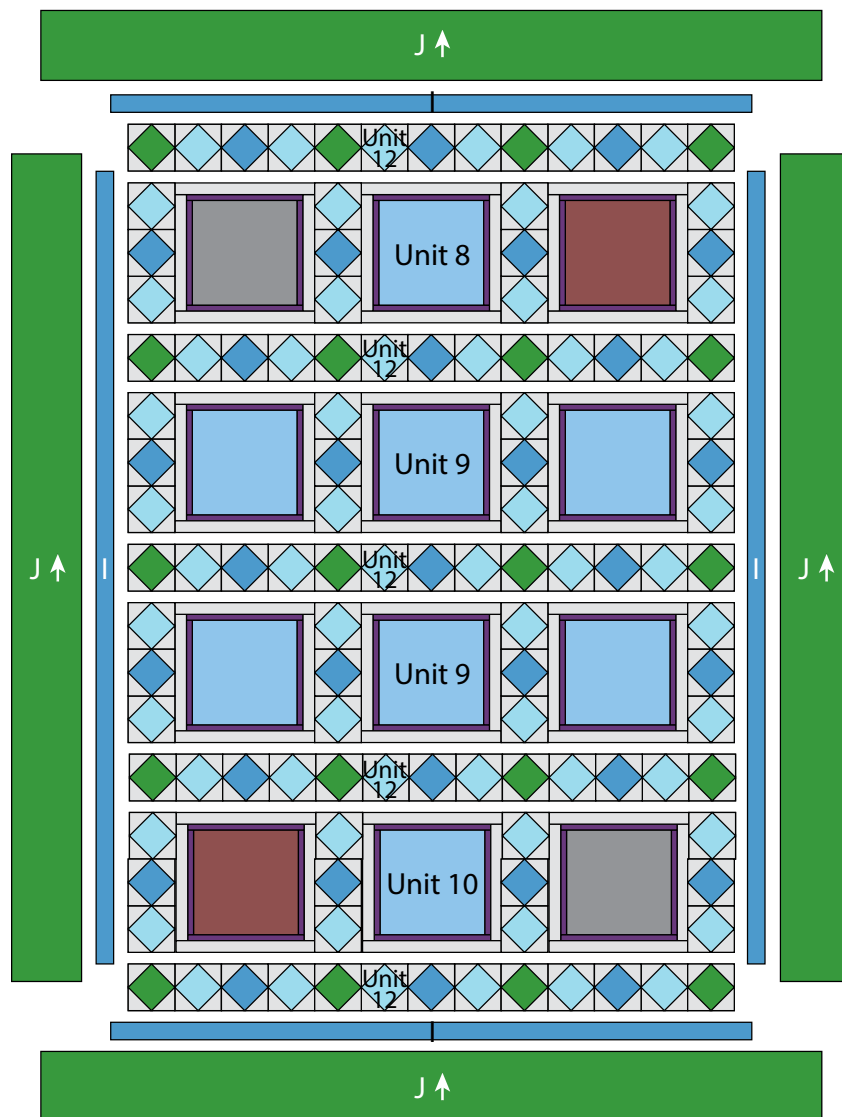
17. Sew (1) 2" x 68 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 55 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 71 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 67 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.
