



¼ yard	Buoys - Navy (G)	1156-77
¼ yard	Mini Tossed Motifs - Light Gray (H)	1158-90
¼ yard	Fish - Blue (I)	1159-75
¼ yard	Set Nautical Motifs - Navy (J)	1160-77
¼ yard	Anchors - Gray (K)	1161-95
¼ yard	Mini Sailboats - White (L)	1162-01
2 ½ yards	Port Town - Blue (M)	1157-75
5 ¼ yards	Patch - Blue (Backing)	1153-75

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 42 ½" strip centered on the panel.

From the Starlet - Cobalt (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 3 ⅜" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Urban Legend - Ivory (C), cut:

- (2) 3 ⅜" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 3 ⅜" squares.
- (7) 1 ¾" x WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ¾" x 10 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 67 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 50 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 27 ½" strips.

From the Lobsters - Red (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Red (E), cut:

- (7) 1 ¾" x WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 70 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.

From the Sailboats - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 10 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (2) 4 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 4 ¾" x 10 ½" strips.

From the Buoys - Navy (G), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" squares.

From the Mini Tossed Motifs - Light Gray (H), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" squares.

From the Fish - Blue (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" squares.

From the Set Nautical Motifs - Navy (J), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" square.

From the Anchors - Gray (K), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" squares.

From the Mini Sailboats - White (L), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" square.

From the Port Town - Blue (M), cut:

- (2) 6" x 87" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6" x 67" LOF strips.

From the Patch - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 91" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 91" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



2. Place (1) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric C square on top of (1) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (48) Unit 1 squares total.



3. Sew (1) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (7) Strip Sets total.



4. Cut the (7) Strip Sets to make (48) 3 " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips (Fig. 6).

5. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the Top Row. Repeat to make the Bottom Row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make the Middle Row. Sew the (3) Rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block One square.



6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 8-13 for fabric identification and placement to make (2) Block Two squares, (2) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares, (1) Block Five square, (2) Block Six squares and (1) Block Seven square.













7. Sew (1) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to make (1) Block Eight rectangle (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (4) Block Eight rectangles total.



8. Sew together (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Six square, (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Three square and (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 15).

9. Sew together (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Five square, (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) Block Six square and (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 16).





10. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Eight rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Eight rectangle and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 17).



11. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Eight rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Eight rectangle and (1) Block Seven square, in that order from left to right, to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 18).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (1) 2 " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 2 " x $67\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $70\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Center (1) 6 " x 87 " Fabric M strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) 6 " x 67 " Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 19).

18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 19), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.




19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.
