



#### **Materials**

3/8 yard	Berries - Blue (A)	1185-77
1/4 yard	Paisley - Green (B)	1188-66
1/4 yard	Glass Texture - Slate (C)	1186-78
1 ½ yards	Stemmed Floral - Ivory (D)	1182-41
1/4 yard	Glass Texture - Rust (E)	1186-33
1/4 yard	Geo Rectangles - Yellow (F)	1181-44
1/4 yard	Geo Rectangles - Brown (G)	1181-39
1/4 yard	Geo Triangles & Circles - Light Brown (H)

1/4 yard	Geo Triangles & Circles - Purple (I)	1184-55

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Berries - Blue (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### From the Paisley - Green (B), cut:

• (16) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Glass Texture - Slate (C), cut:

• (16) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Stemmed Floral - Ivory (D), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (60) Template 1 triangles.
- (60) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Glass Texture - Rust (E), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Geo Rectangles - Yellow (F), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Geo Rectangles - Brown (G), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Geo Triangles & Circles - Light Brown (H), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Geo Triangles & Circles - Purple (I), cut:

• (14) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Glass Texture - Purple (J), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (14) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Stemmed Floral - Rose (K), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Stitch Pattern - Green (L), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Packed Floral - Medium Blue (M), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (14) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Glass Texture - Medium Blue (N), cut:

• (14) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Paisley - Orange (O), cut:

• (16) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Stitch Pattern - Pink (P), cut:

• (16) Template 2 triangles.

#### From the Paisley - Purple (Q), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Stitch Pattern - Blue (R), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### From the Geo Rectangles - Turquoise (S), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### From the Berries - Blue (Backing), cut:

• (2) 60" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 68" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

# Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components.

1. Sew (1) Fabric C-Template 1 triangle and (1) Fabric D-Template 1 triangle together along the long sides to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). The unit should measure 4 ½" x 2 ½". Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 rectangles total.







2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-8 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (16) Unit 2 rectangles, (14) Unit 3 rectangles, (14) Unit 4 rectangles, (14) Unit 5 rectangles, (14) Unit 6 rectangles, (16) Unit 7 rectangles and (16) Unit 8 rectangles.






- 3. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square to the left end of (1) Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square to the right end of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 9). The square should measure 8 ½" square. Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.
- 4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 10-12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (7) Block Two squares, (7) Block Three squares and (8) Block Four squares.

- 5. Sew (13) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric J strips and (13) assorted 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make one Side Border (Fig. 13). Repeat to make a second Side Border.
- 6. Sew (11) assorted 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (11) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric J strips together lengthwise and alternating them. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric L square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 14 below). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.


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#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 7. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.
- 8. Repeat Step 1 and refer to the Quilt Layout for component identification and placement to make Row Two through Row Six.
- 9. Sew the (6) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

- 10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric Q strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 14. Bind as desired.
