



1 3/8 yards	Tonal Leaf - Maroon (B)	1136-58*
5/8 yard	Allover Floral - Ecu (C)	1140-41
1 2/3 yards	Tiny Butterflies - Aqua (D)	1141-11
5/8 yard	Tossed Owls - Gray (E)	1138-90
2/3 yard	Blocks - Black (F)	1137-99
1/3 yard	Feathers - Aqua (G)	1135-11
7/8 yard	Starlet - Olive (H)	6383-Olive
3/4 yard	Starlet - Gray (I)	6383-Gray
2 1/3 yards	Owl Collage - Pink (J)	1134-22
5 1/2 yards	Tonal Leaf - Teal (Backing)	1136-67

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Aqua (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" strip centered on the panel.

From the Tonal Leaf - Maroon (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips piece as needed.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Allover Floral - Ecu (C), cut:

- (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (2) 3 1/2" x 30 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Tiny Butterflies - Aqua (D), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (6) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 78 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Tossed Owls - Gray (E), cut:

- (2) 8 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 1/4" x 7 3/4" strips.

From the Blocks - Black (F):

- Fussy cut (14) 8 1/4" x 7 3/4" strips each centered on an owl.

From the Feathers - Aqua (G), cut:

- (1) 8 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 1/4" x 7 3/4" strips.

From the Starlet - Olive (H), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 7 3/4" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 11 1/4" strips.
- (2) 1 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/8" x 7 3/4" strips.
- (2) 1 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 3/8" x 9 1/2" strips.

From the Starlet - Gray (I), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 7 3/4" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 11 1/4" strips.
- (3) 1 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 1/8" x 7 3/4" strips.
- (3) 1 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 3/8" x 9 1/2" strips.

From the Owl Collage - Pink (J), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 81 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 1/2" x 73 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tonal Leaf - Teal (Backing), cut:

- (2) 99" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 81" x 99" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2" to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 30 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle (Fig. 2).





3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 50\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 2 rectangle. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 32\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).



4. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{8}'' \times 7\frac{3}{4}''$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 7\frac{3}{4}''$ Fabric G strip. Sew (1) $1\frac{3}{8}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H strip to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 square.



5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figures 5-7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) $9\frac{1}{2}''$ Unit 4 squares, (2) $9\frac{1}{2}''$ Unit 5 squares and (4) $9\frac{1}{2}''$ Unit 6 squares.







6. Sew (1) $2'' \times 7\frac{3}{4}''$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 7\frac{3}{4}''$ Fabric F strip. Sew (1) $2'' \times 11\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F strip. Trim the block to measure $9\frac{1}{2}''$ square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Unit 7 squares total.



7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) $9\frac{1}{2}''$ Unit 8 squares.



8. Follow Figure 10 and sew together (6) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric D strips and (6) assorted units to make the Left Border.





10. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figure 12 for component identification, placement and orientation. Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric D strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border.



11. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figure 13 for component identification, location and orientation. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


14. Sew (1) 2" x 78 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 63 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 81 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 73 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (9) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.
