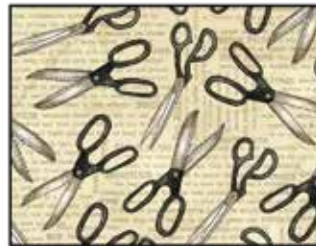

1 $\frac{2}{3}$ yards	Sewing Motifs - Medium Brown (F)	1194-35
$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Tape Measure - Light Brown (G)	1198-30*
3 yards	Tossed Sewing Machines - Ivory (Backing)	1193-41

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel 24" - Ivory (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Urban Legend - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Meandering Stitch - Medium Brown (C), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares and (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares across both diagonals to make (36) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

From the Sewing Words - Ivory (D), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (32) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the American Honor - Blue (E), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

From the Sewing Motifs - Medium Brown (F), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, piece as needed.

From the Tape Measure - Light Brown (G), cut:

- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Sewing Machines - Ivory (Backing), cut:

- (2) 50" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 50" x 70" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components.

- Sew (1) 2" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. **Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ "** to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

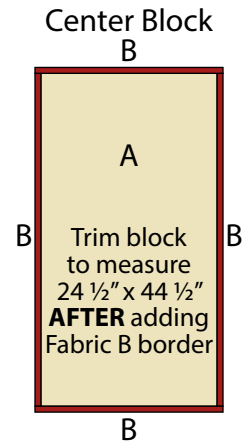

- Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C triangle and (1) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) Unit 1 block. The block should measure 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.

- Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (16) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 squares.

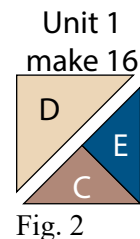

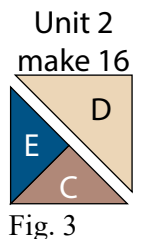

- Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square along the Fabric E sides to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (14) Unit 3 strips total.

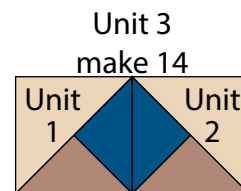

- Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 squares.

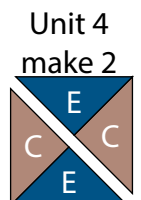

6. Place (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C square on top of (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 6). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 5 squares (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.

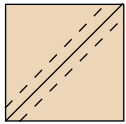

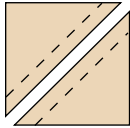

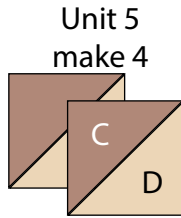

7. Sew together (2) Unit 3 strips, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 1 square and (2) Unit 3 strips, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

8. Sew together (3) Unit 3 strips together end to end. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 10). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top. The arrows in the Quilt Layout represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the orientation of fabrics.)

9. Sew the Side, Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block.

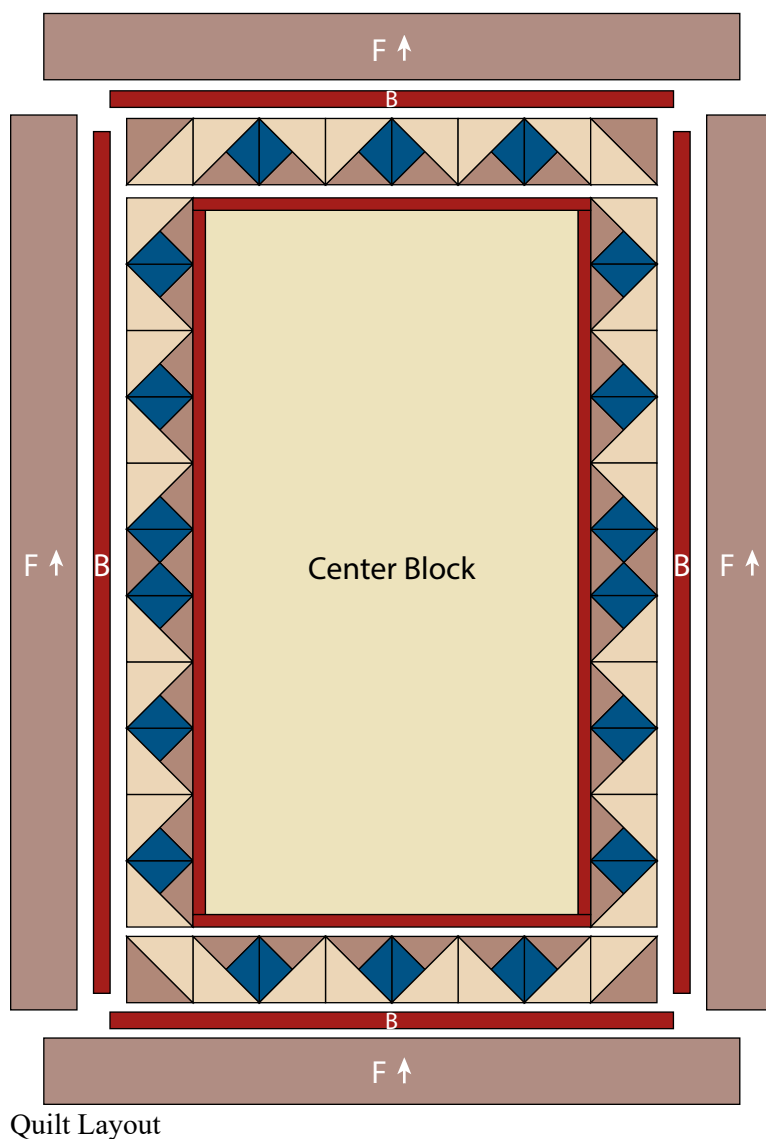
10. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
