

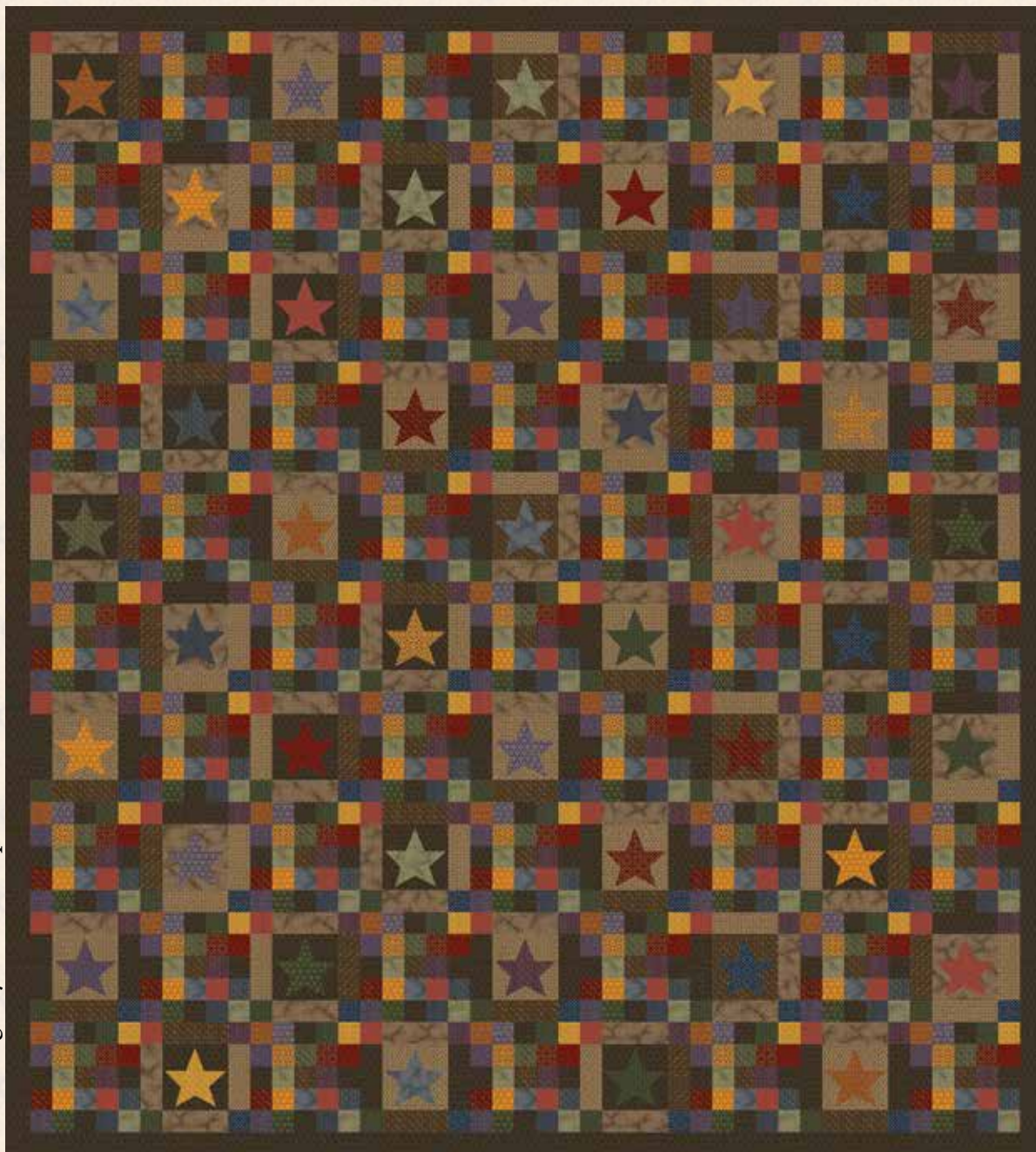

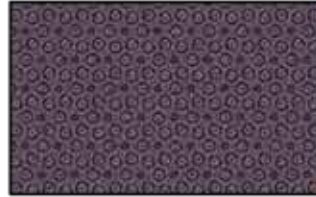

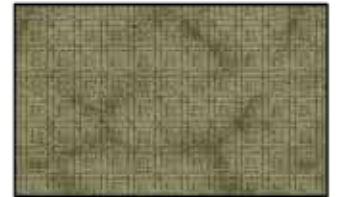

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Scroll Dots - Ochre (A), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Dots - Purple (B), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Dots - Brown (C), cut:

- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 6 ½" squares.
- (12) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 100 ½" strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 94 ½" strips.
- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Scroll Dots - Olive (D), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (45) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Stripe - Ochre (E), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Wool Texture - Burnt Red (F), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (45) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Scroll Dots - Purple (G), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Stars - Ochre (H), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Stripe - Olive (I), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (1) star.

From the Stars - Burnt Red (J), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Dots - Burnt Red (K), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Stitched Squares - Olive (L), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Stripe - Brown (M), cut:

- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Stripe - Purple (N), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (45) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Stripe - Burnt Red (O), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Dots - Ochre (P), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Stitched Squares - Slate (Q), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Stripe - Slate (R), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (1) star.

From the Wool Texture - Purple (S), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Dots - Olive (T), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) stars.

From the Wool Texture - Slate (U), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Scroll Dots - Brown (V), cut:

- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 6 ½" squares.
- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Stitched Squares - Brown (W), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 6 ½" squares.
- (4) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Stars - Slate (X), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (45) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (3) stars.

From the Stitched Squares - Brown (Backing), cut:

- (3) 102" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 102" x 112" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip, (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strip, (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strip and (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) AE strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (3) AE strip sets total.

2. Cut the AE strip sets into (45) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).

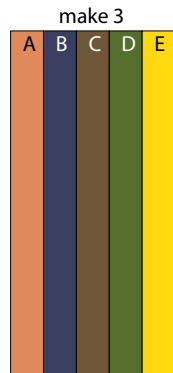

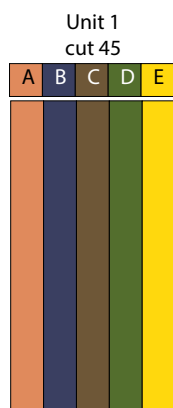

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and use Figures 3-10 for fabric identification and location to make (45) Unit 2 strips, (45) Unit 3 strips, (45) Unit 4 strips and (45) Unit 5 strips.

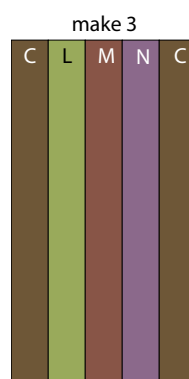

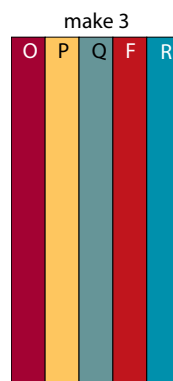

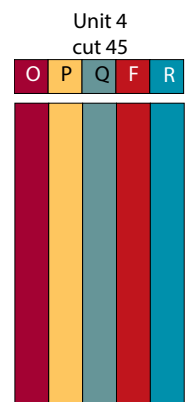

4. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Unit 3 strip, (1) Unit 4 strip and (1) Unit 5 strip together lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (45) Block One squares total.

5. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric V strip to the left side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric M strip to the right side of the Fabric C square.

6. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric F square to the left end of (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric W strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric N square to the right end of the Fabric W strip. Sew the new strip to the top of the Fabric C square from Step 5.

7. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to the left end of (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric W strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric X square to the right end of the Fabric W strip. Sew the new strip to the bottom of the Fabric C square from Step 6 to make (1) Unit 6 block (Fig. 12).

8. Repeat Steps 5-7 to make (9) Unit 6 blocks total.

9. Repeat Steps 5-7 and use Figures 13-18 for fabric identification and location to make (15) Unit 7 blocks, (5) Unit 8 blocks, (8) Unit 9 blocks, (6) Unit 10 blocks, (1) Unit 11 block and (1) Unit 12 block.

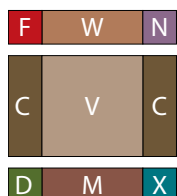

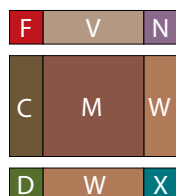

10. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

11. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

12. Refer to Figure 19 to arrange and press (1) Fabric A star onto (1) Unit 6 block.

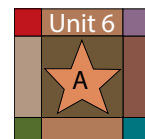

13. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Two square.

14. Repeat Steps 12-13 and use Figures 20-57 for fabric and unit identification to make the designated number of blocks, Block Three through Block Forty. There will be a total of (45) blocks total. Make (2) of Block Three, Block Ten, Block Eleven, Block Thirteen, Block Sixteen and Block Twenty-Nine.

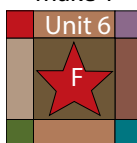

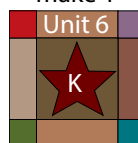

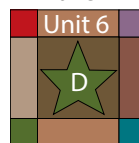

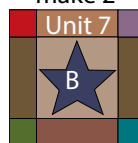

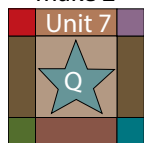

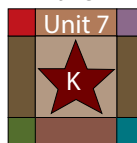

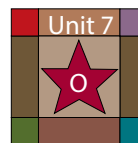

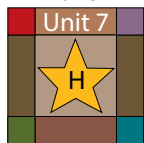

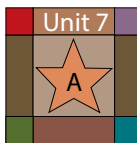

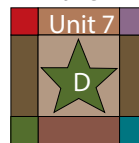

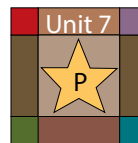

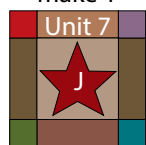

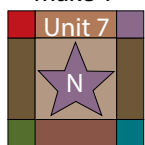

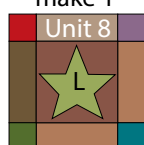

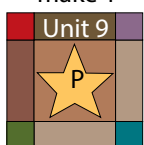

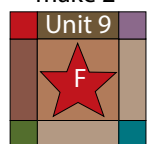

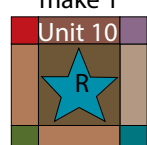

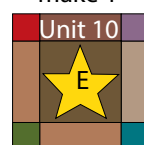

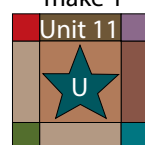

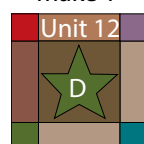

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

15. Following the quilt layout, sew (5) assorted pieced blocks and (4) Block One squares together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three, Five, Seven and Nine.

16. Following the quilt layout, sew (5) Block One squares and (4) assorted pieced blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four, Six, Eight and Ten.

17. Sew the (10) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

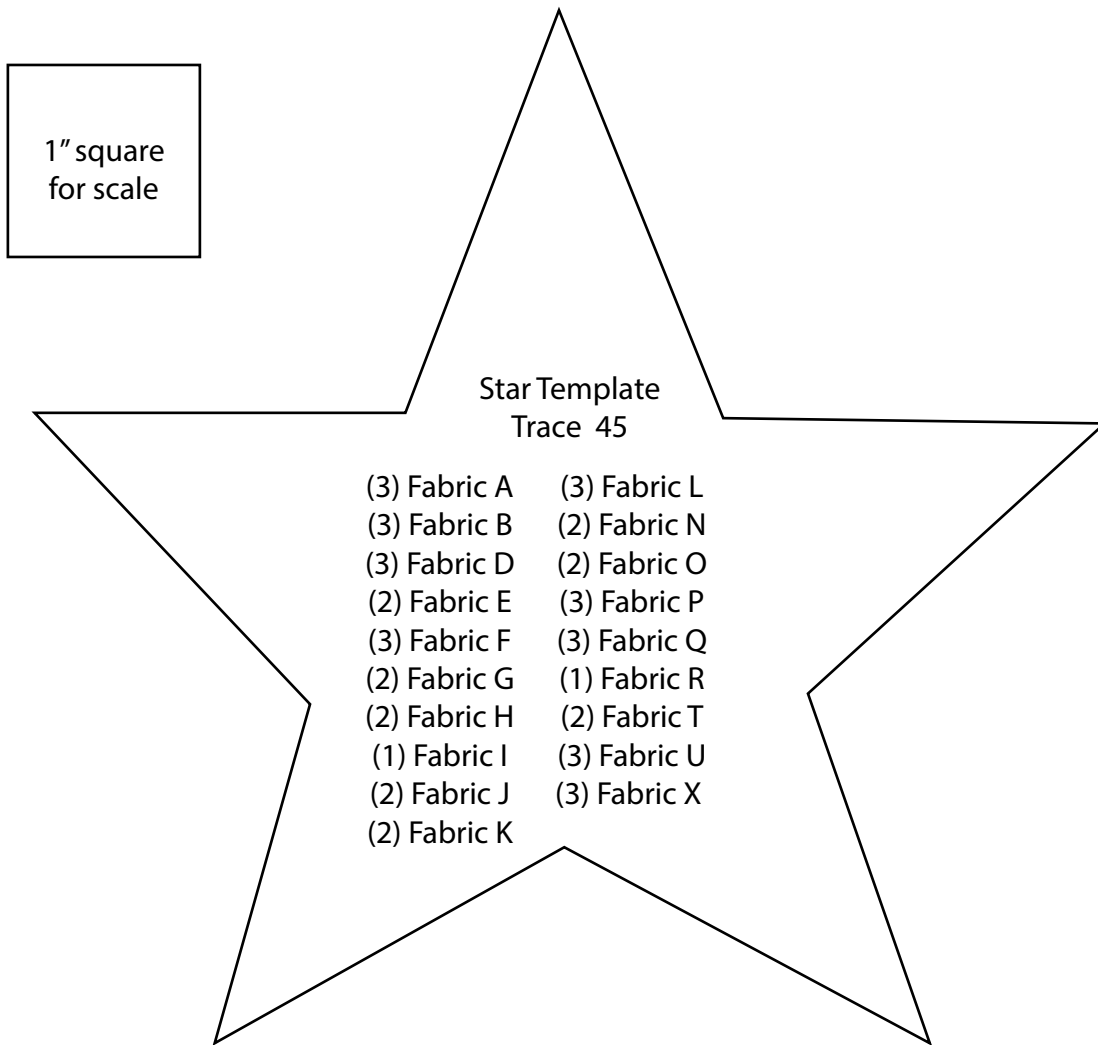
18. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 100 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 94 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (10) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.
