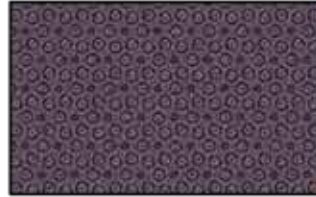

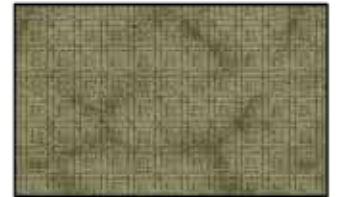

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Scroll Dots - Brown (A), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 12 ½" x 20 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Stripe - Brown (B), cut:

- (2) 12 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 12 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Long Stems.

#### From the Stitched Squares - Brown (C), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 12 ½" x 20 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Dots - Brown (D), cut:

- (2) 12 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 12 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- See instructions to cut (4) Right Bellies.
- See instructions to cut (4) Left Bellies.

#### From the Scroll Dots - Ochre (E), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Stars for Flower Three.
- See instructions to cut five Flower Four centers.

#### From the Scroll Dots - Purple (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower One centers.

#### From the Scroll Dots - Olive (G), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (8) Outer Bases.

#### From the Stripe - Ochre (H), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Three stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Two stars.
- See instructions to cut (5) Flower Four stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Right Stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Left Stars.

#### From the Stripe - Purple (I), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Stripe - Olive (J), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (8) Stems.
- See instructions to cut (20) Large Leaves.

#### From the Stripe - Slate (K), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Three centers.

#### From the Stripe - Burnt Red (L), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Ones.
- See instructions to cut (4) Right Wings.

#### From the Stitched Squares - Olive (M), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (8) Inner Bases.
- See instructions to cut (8) Small Leaves.
- See instructions to cut (44) Large Leaves.

#### From the Stitched Squares - Slate (N), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Dots - Ochre (O), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower One Stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Two Stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Right Stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Left Stars.

## Cutting Instructions - Continued

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

**From the Dots - Purple (P), cut:**

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Two centers.

**From the Dots - Olive (Q), cut:**

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (16) Small Leaves.
- See instructions to cut (48) Large Leaves.

**From the Dots - Burnt Red (R), cut:**

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Ones.
- See instructions to cut (4) Left Birds.

**From the Stars - Ochre (S), cut:**

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower One Stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Right Stars.
- See instructions to cut (4) Left Stars.

**From the Stars - Slate (T), cut:**

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Two centers.
- See instructions to cut (5) Flower Fours.

**From the Stars - Burnt Red (U), cut:**

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 1/2" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Twos.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Threes.
- See instructions to cut (4) Left Wings.

**From the Wool Texture - Purple (V), cut:**

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Three centers.

**From the Wool Texture - Slate (W), cut:**

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower One centers.

**From the Wool Texture - Burnt Red (X), cut:**

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Twos.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flower Threes.
- See instructions to cut (4) Right Birds.

**From the Scroll Dots - Brown (Backing), cut:**

- (2) 72" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 72" back.

## Sewing Instructions

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press (1) Fabric M Inner Base, (1) Fabric G Outer Base, (1) Fabric J Stem, (1) Fabric M Small Leaf, (1) Fabric Q Small Leaf, (3) Fabric M Large Leaves, (3) Fabric Q Large Leaves, (1) Fabric L Flower One, (1) Fabric F Flower One Center, (1) Fabric O Flower One Star, (1) Fabric U Flower Two, (1) Fabric P Flower Two Center, (1) Fabric H Flower Two Star, (1) Fabric X Flower Three, (1) Fabric K Flower Three Center and (1) Fabric E Flower Three Star onto (1) 12 1/2" Fabric D square.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make Unit 1 block.
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (4) Unit 1 blocks total.
6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and use Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make (4) Unit 2 blocks, (2) Unit 3 rectangles and (2) Unit 4 rectangles.

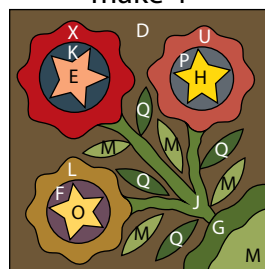

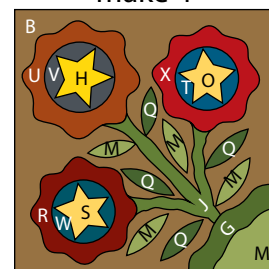
Unit 2

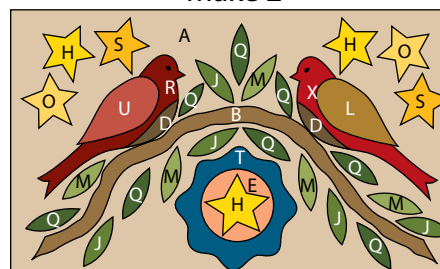
Unit 3

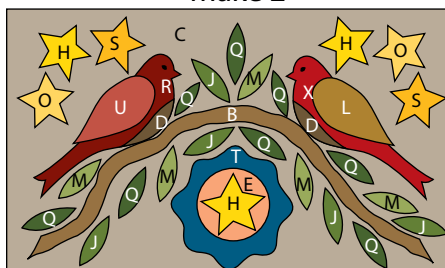

7. Sew (12) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 6-block strip. Sew the strip to the left side of (1) Unit 1 block.
8. Sew (16) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 8-block strip. Sew the strip to the top of the Unit 1 block to make one Block One square (Fig. 5).
9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make a second Block One square.
10. Sew (12) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 6-block strip. Sew the strip to the right side of (1) Unit 2 block.
11. Sew (16) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 8-block strip. Sew the strip to the top of the Unit 2 block to make one Block Two square (Fig. 6).
12. Repeat Steps 10-11 to make a second Block Two square.

13. Sew (12) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 6-block strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the (1) strip to the each side of (1) Unit 3 rectangle.
14. Sew (28) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 14-block strip. Sew the strip to the bottom of the Unit 3 rectangle to make one Block Three rectangle (Fig. 7).
15. Repeat Steps 13-14 to make a second Block Three rectangle.

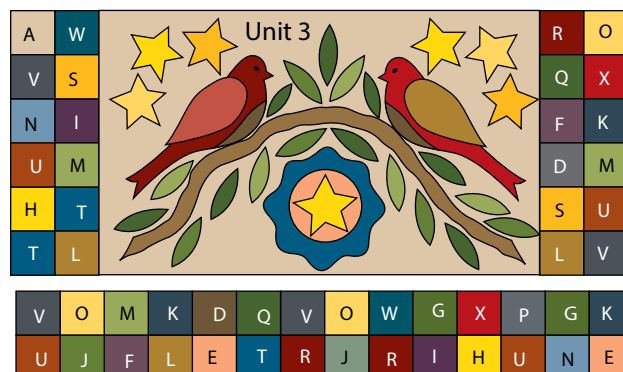

16. Sew (12) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 6-block strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the (1) strip to the each side of (1) Unit 4 rectangle.
17. Sew (28) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into a 2-block by 14-block strip. Sew the strip to the bottom of the Unit 4 rectangle to make one Block Four rectangle (Fig. 8).
18. Repeat Steps 16-17 to make a second Block Four rectangle.

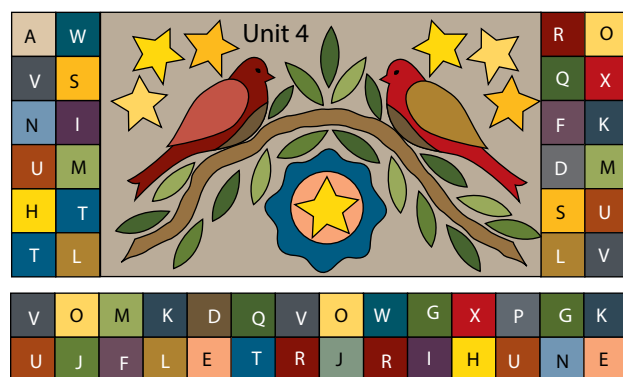

19. Sew (6) assorted 2 1/2" blocks into (1) Side Strip. Sew the Side Strip to the right side of (1) Unit 2 block. Sew (7) assorted 2 1/2" squares together to make (1) Bottom Strip. Sew the Bottom Strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 block.

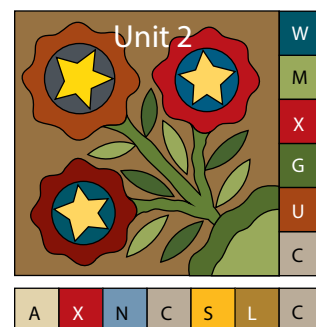

20. Sew (6) assorted 2 ½" blocks into (1) Side Strip. Sew the Side Strip to the right side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (7) assorted 2 ½" squares together to make (1) Bottom Strip. Sew the Bottom Strip to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Unit 6 block (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 block.

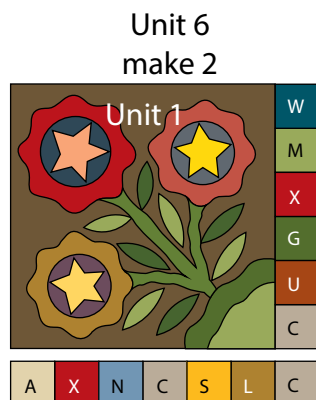

21. Sew (1) Unit 5 block to the left side of (1) Unit 6 block to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 6 block to the left side of (1) Unit 5 block to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 11). Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks.

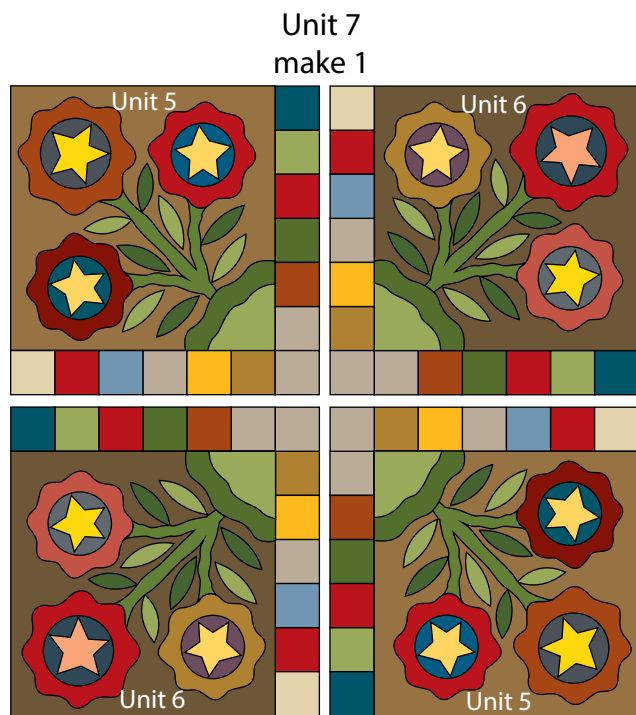

22. Repeat Steps 3-4 and use Figure 12 to arrange and press (1) Fabric T Flower Four, (1) Fabric E Flower Four Center and (1) Fabric H Flower Four Star onto the center of the Unit 7 block to make (1) Block Five square.

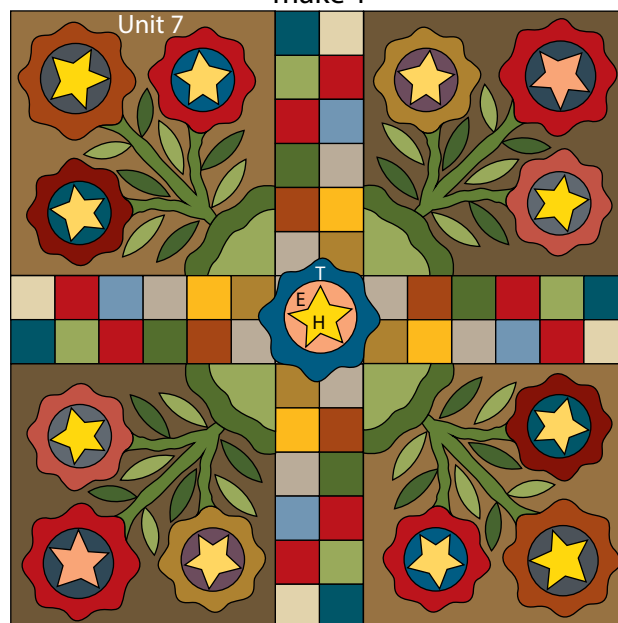

### Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout on Page 7 while assembling*)

23. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) Block Two square together to make the Row One.

24. Sew (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Five square and (1) Block Three rectangle together lengthwise to make Row Two.

25. Sew (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) Block One square together to make the Row Three.

26. Sew the (3) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.

27. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

28. Layer and quilt as desired.

29. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

30. Bind as desired.

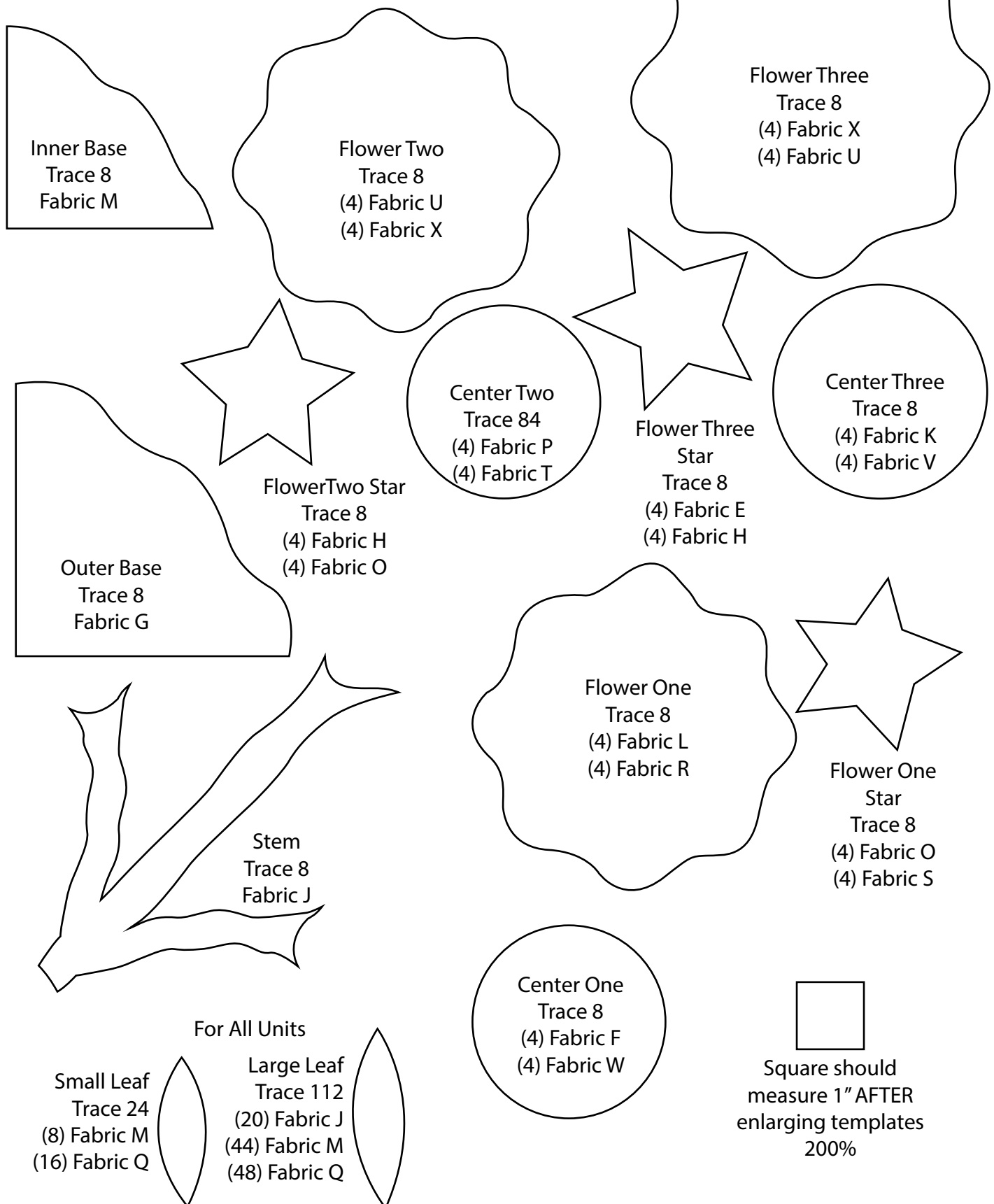

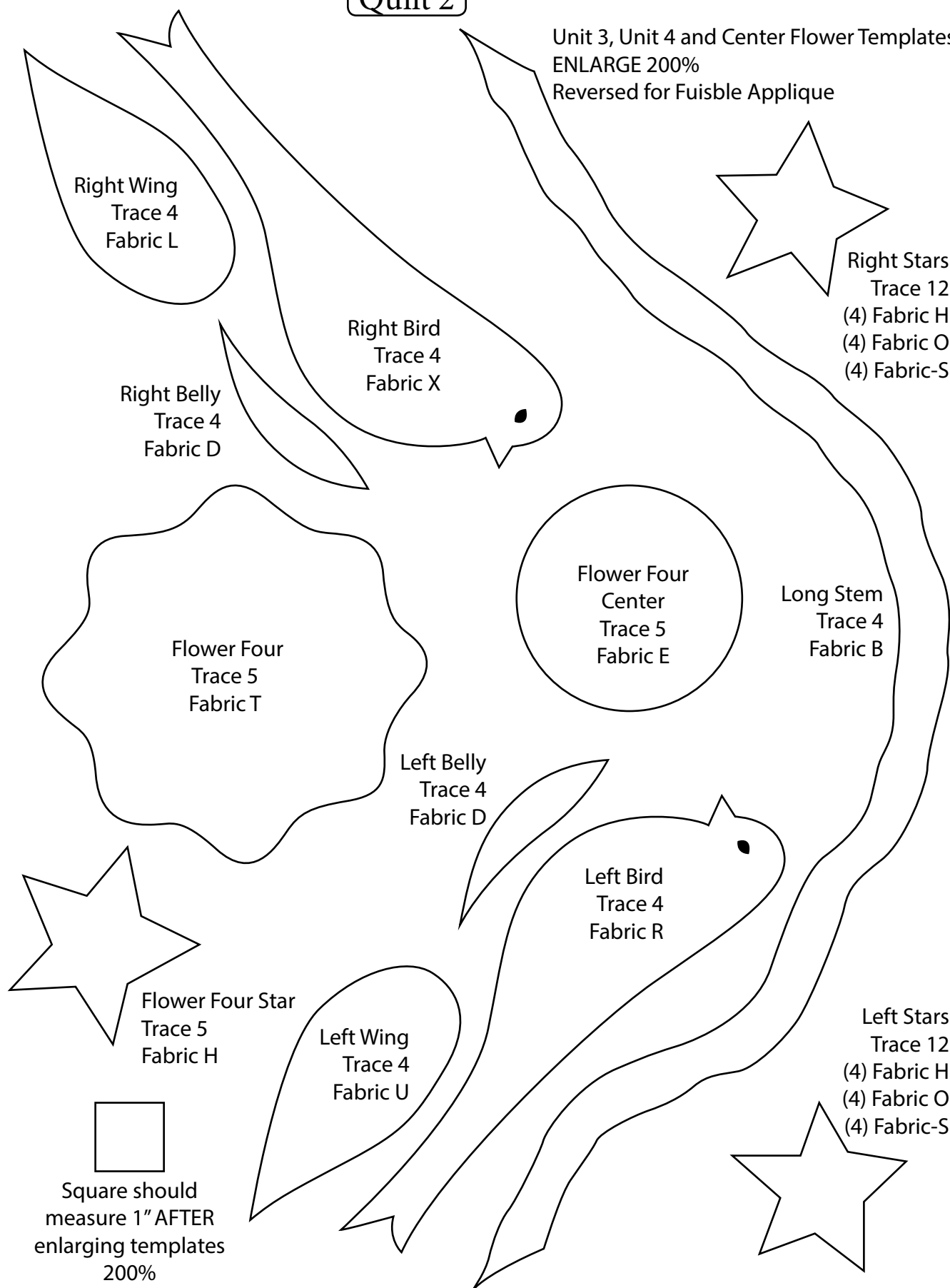
