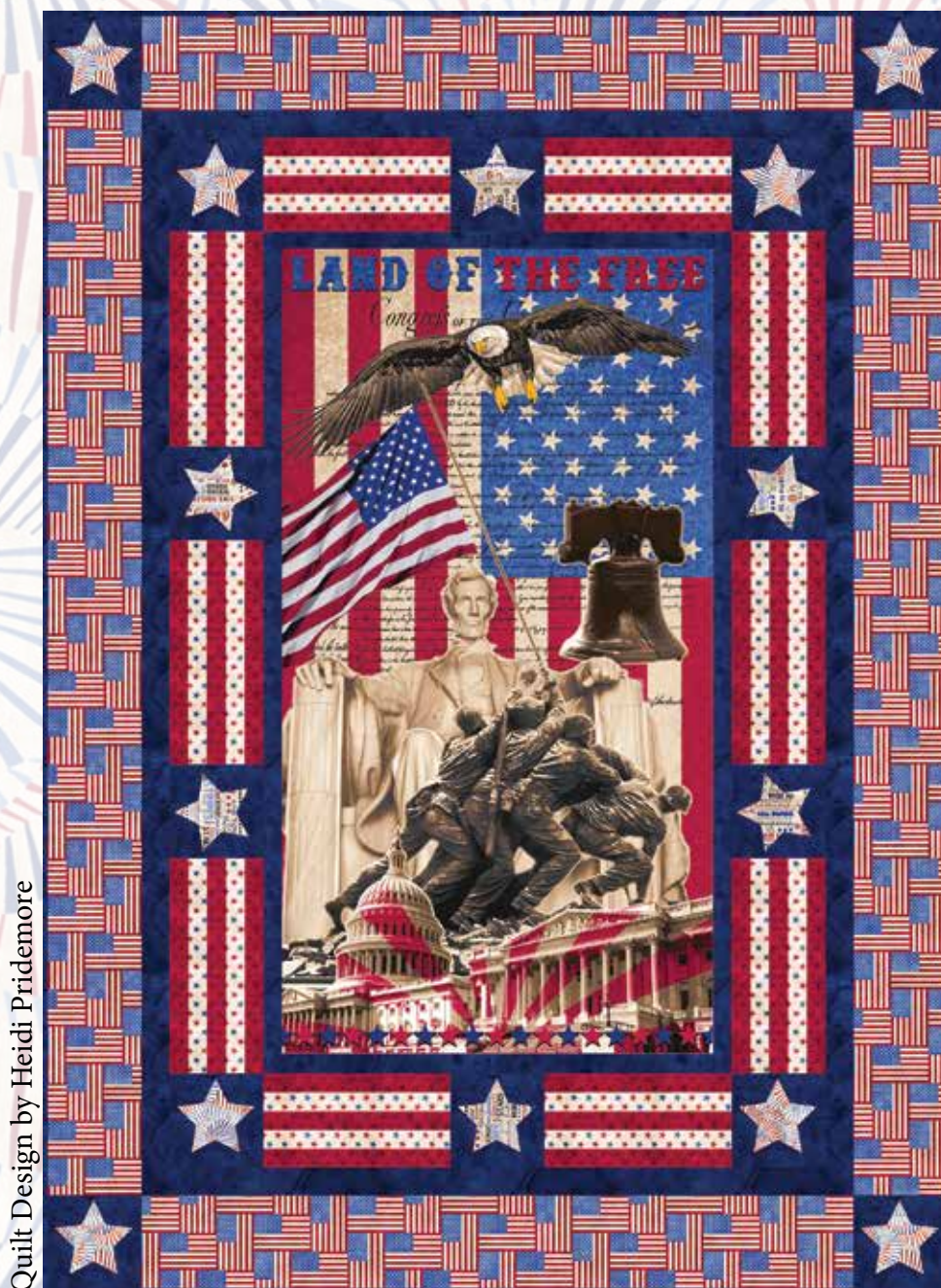

1 panel	24" Panel - Red (A)	9509P-88
1 ½" yards	Urban Legend - Navy (B)	7101-77*
½ yards	Stars - Red (C)	9513-88
¾ yards	Stars - Tan (D)	9513-41
¼ yards	Swirls - Tan (E)	9514-41
¼ yards	Star Spangle Banner Words - Tan (F)	9511-41
1 ¾ yards	Flags - Blue (G)	9512-77
4 ¼ yards	America - Red (Backing)	9515-18

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Panel - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23 ½" x 43 ½" panel.

From the Urban Legend - Navy (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 5 ½" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Stars - Red (C), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 12" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Stars - Tan (D), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 12" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Swirls - Tan (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (8) Stars.

From the Star Spangle Banner Words - Tan (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (6) Stars.

From the Flags - Blue (G), cut:

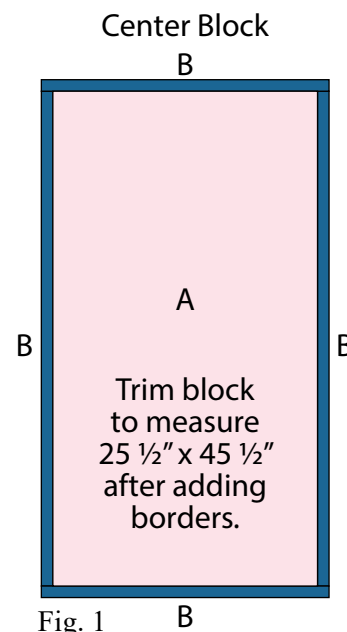
- (2) 5 ½" x 58 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the America - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 76" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 76" back.

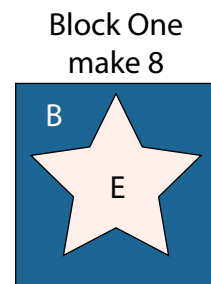
Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 43 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 23 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 25 ½" x 45 ½".



2. Following the manufacturer's instructions to trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

3. Refer to Figure 2 to arrange and press the (8) Fabric E stars onto the (8) 5 ½" Fabric B squares to make (8) Block One squares. Pay attention to the orientation of the Stars.

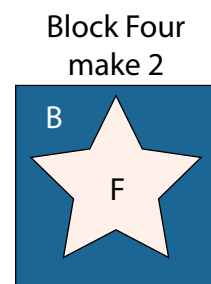
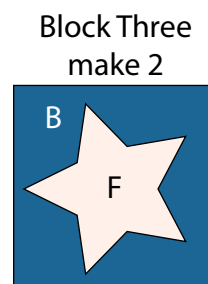
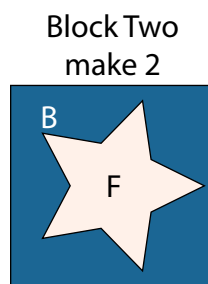


4. Refer to Figure 3 below to arrange and press the (2) Fabric F stars onto the (2) 5 ½" Fabric B squares to make (2) Block Two squares. Pay attention to the orientation of the Stars.

5. Refer to Figure 4 to arrange and press the (2) Fabric F stars onto the (2) 5 ½" Fabric B squares to make (2) Block Three squares. Pay attention to the orientation of the Stars.

6. Refer to Figure 5 to arrange and press the (2) Fabric F stars onto the (2) 5 ½" Fabric B squares to make (2) Block Four squares. Pay attention to the orientation of the Stars.

7. Finish the raw edges of each star with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.



8. Sew together (3) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strips and (2) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strips lengthwise, alternating them, to make (1) Block Five strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block Five strips total.

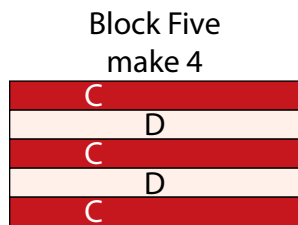

9. Sew together (3) 1 ½" x 12" Fabric C strips and (2) 1 ½" x 12" Fabric D strips lengthwise, alternating them, to make (1) Block Six strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Block Six strips total.

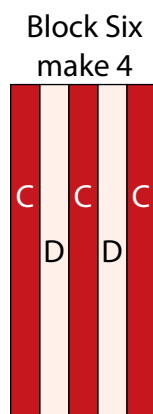

10. Sew together (3) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strips and (2) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strips lengthwise, alternating them, to make (1) Block Seven strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (2) Block Seven strips total.

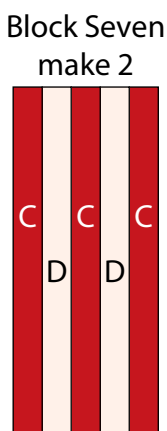

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

11. Sew together (2) Block Six strips, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Seven strip and (1) Block Three square to make (1) Inner Side Border Strip. Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border Strip. Sew (1) Inner Side Border Strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the border strip orientations. Sew together (2) Block One squares, (2) Block Five strips and (1) Block Four square to make (1) Inner Top Border Strip. Repeat to make (1) Inner Bottom Border Strip. Sew the Inner Top Border Strip and the Inner Bottom Border Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the border strip orientations.

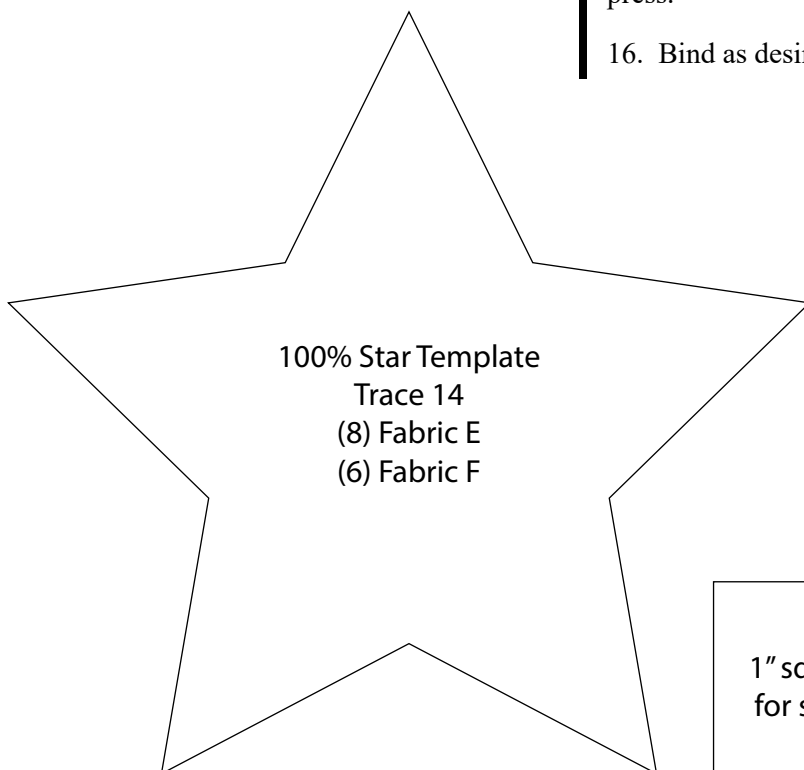
12. Sew (1) 2" x 55 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 38 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric G strip to make (1) Outer Top Border Strip. Repeat to make (1) Outer Bottom Border Strip. Sew the Outer Top Border Strip and the Outer Bottom Border Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the border strip orientations.

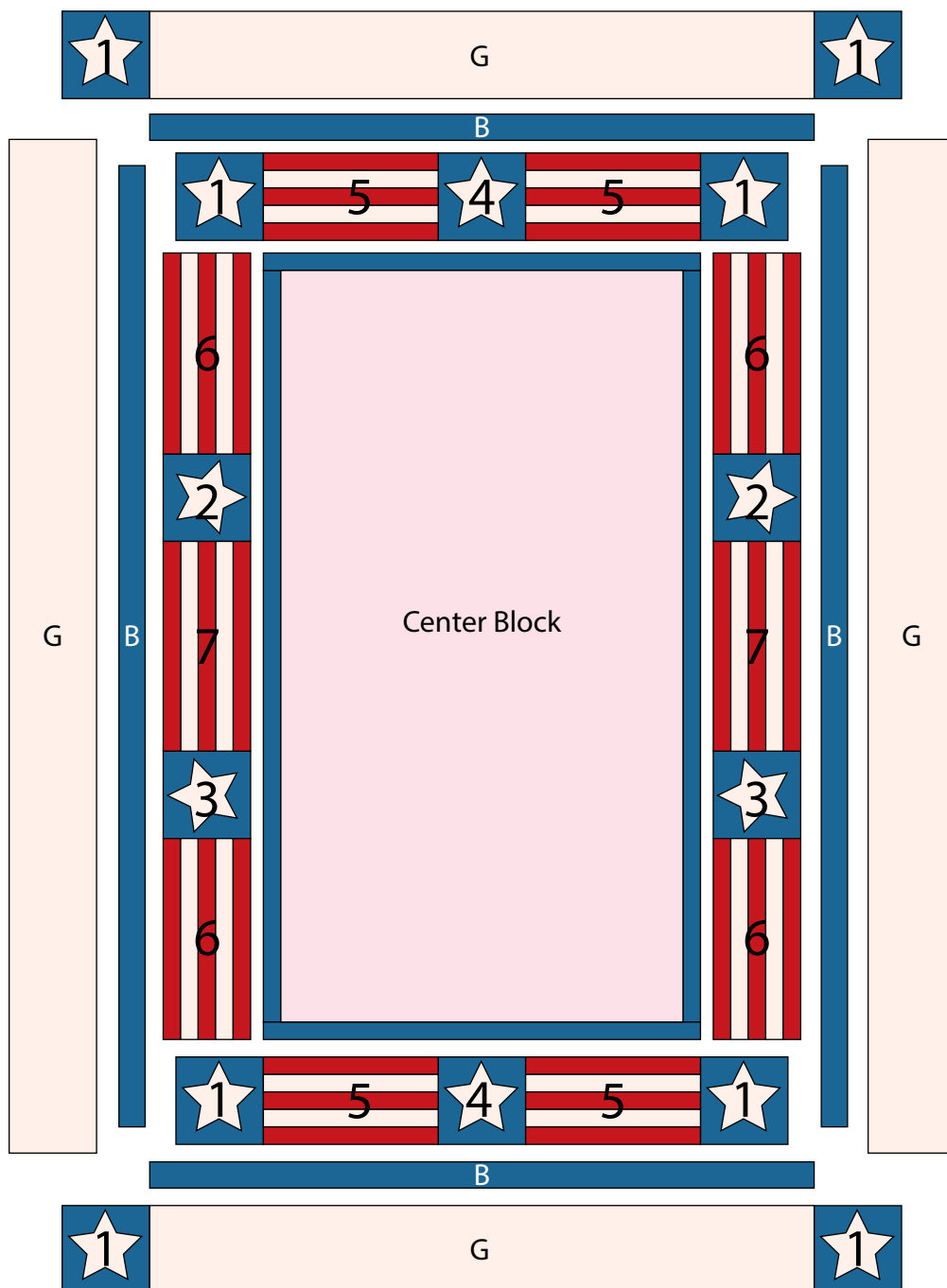
14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
