Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Starlet - Lilac (A), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Sky (B), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - Lime (C), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Coral (D), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - Orange (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Navy (F), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Teal (G), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Yellow (H), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Pink (I), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Purple (J), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - Royal (K), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" squares.

From the Starlet - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - Kiwi (M), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Turq. (N), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" square.
- (8) 2" squares.

From the Starlet - Papaya (R), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Starlet - White (S), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" x 3 1/2" strips.
- (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x 29 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 33 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Starlet - Black (T), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starlet - White (Backing), cut:

- (1) 41" x 51" strip for the backing.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric B square to the left side of (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric S strip to make (1) BS strip. Sew (1) BS strip to the top of (1) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric S strip to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

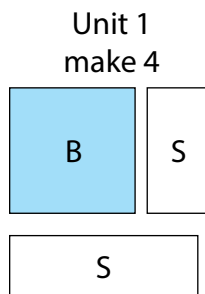

2. Place (1) 2" Fabric S square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 3).

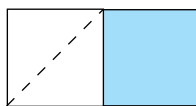

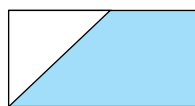

3. Place another 2" Fabric S square on the right side of the 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 strips total.

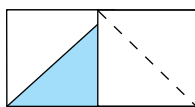

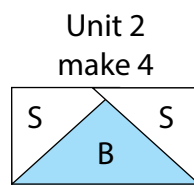

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and follow Figure 6 for fabric locations to make (4) Unit 3 strips.

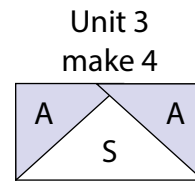

5. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.

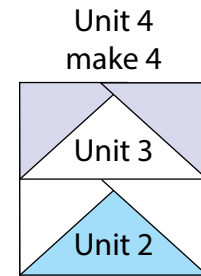

6. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric A square to make (1) middle block row. Pay attention to the Unit 4 orientations. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the top block row. Pay attention to the Unit 1 orientations. Repeat to make the bottom block row. Sew the top and bottom block rows to the middle block row, paying attention to the row orientations, to make (1) Block One (Fig. 8).

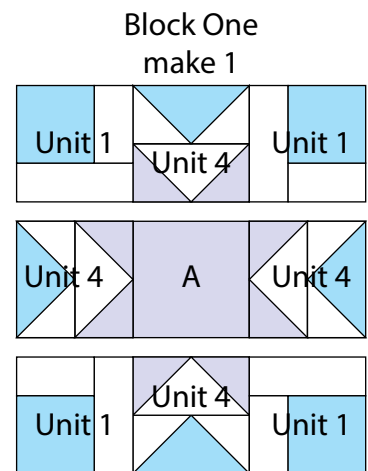

7. Repeat Steps 1-6 using Figures 9-19 for fabric identifications and fabric locations to make (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Four, (1) Block Five, (1) Block Six, (1) Block Seven, (1) Block Eight, (1) Block Nine, (1) Block Ten, (1) Block Eleven and (1) Block Twelve.

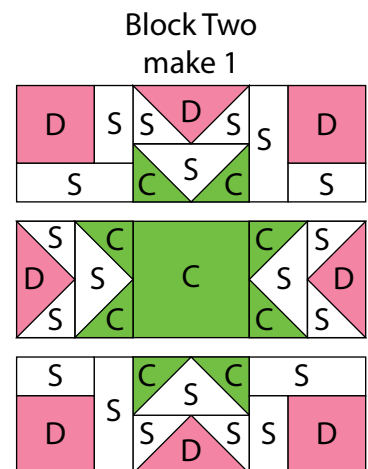

make 1

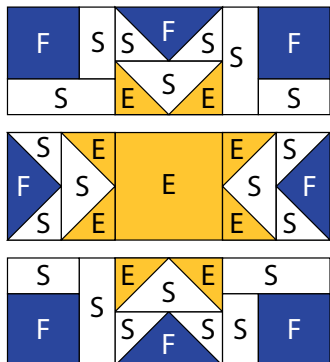

make 1

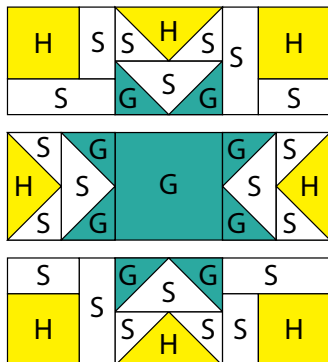

make 1

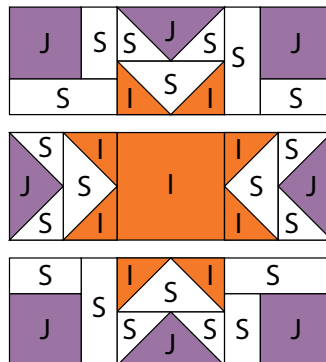

make 1

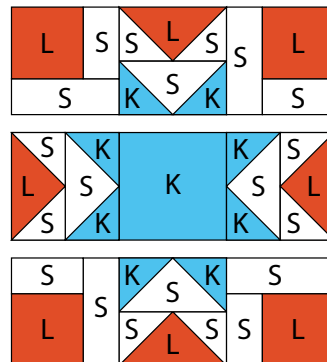

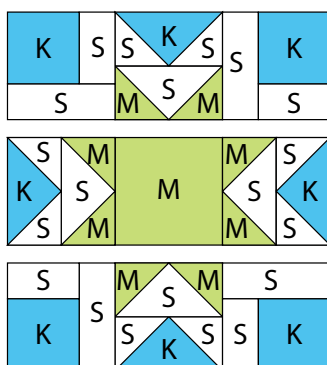

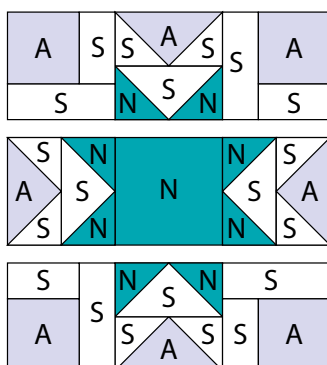

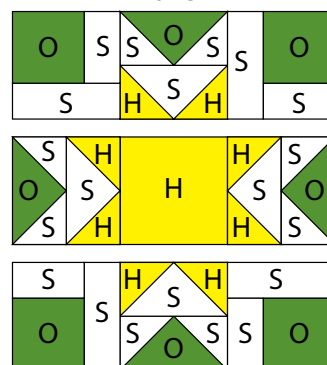

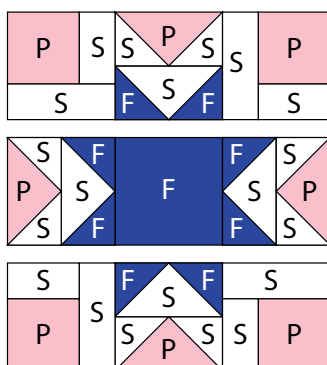

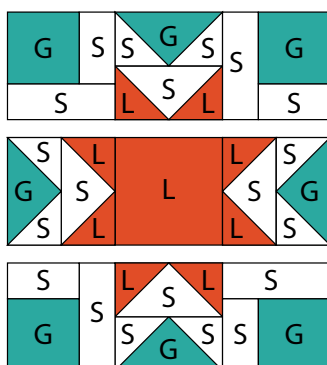

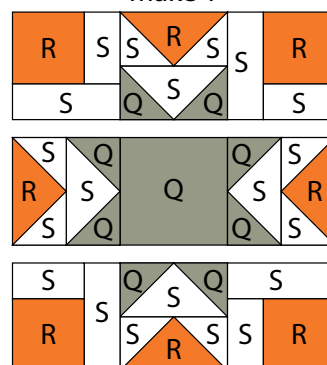

STARLET BASICS

Quilt 1

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

8. Sew together (1) Block One, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip, (1) Block Two, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip and (1) Block Three, in that order, to make Row One.

9. Sew together (1) Block Four, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip, (1) Block Five, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip and (1) Block Six, in that order, to make Row Two.

10. Sew together (1) Block Seven, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip, (1) Block Eight, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip and (1) Block Nine, in that order, to make Row Three.

11. Sew together (1) Block Ten, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip, (1) Block Eleven, (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric S strip and (1) Block Twelve, in that order, to make Row Four.

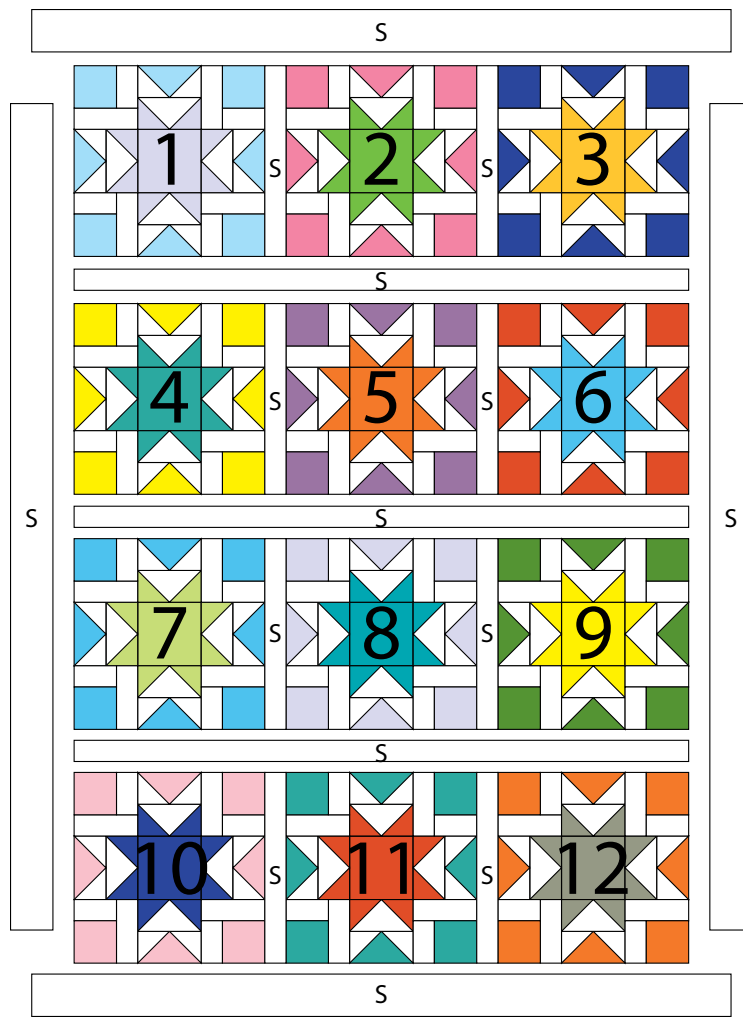
12. Sew together to Row One, (1) 1 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric S strip, Row Two, (1) 1 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric S strip, Row Three, (1) 1 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric S strip and Row Four, in that order, to make the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 39 ½" Fabric S strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric S strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric T strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
