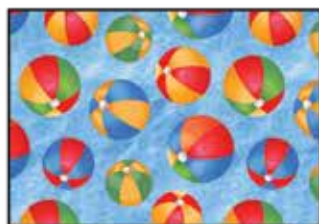

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	Starlet - Red (B)	6383-Red*
$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Sand Texture - Sand (C)	9532-41
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Starlet - Royal (D)	6383-Royal
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Water Texture - Blue (E)	9536-70
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Starlet - Yellow (F)	6383-Yellow
$1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards	Stripe - Sand (G)	9535-41
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Beach Toys - White (H)	9530-01
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Beach Balls - Blue (I)	9531-70
$3 \frac{1}{2}$ yards	Sandy Beach Scene - Sand (Backing)	9527-41

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Beach Blocks - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (10) $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " squares each centered on a block.

From the Starlet - Red (B), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
- (5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Sand Texture - Sand (C), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 7 " strips.
- (2) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

From the Starlet - Royal (D), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

From the Water Texture - Blue (E), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 7 " strips.

From the Starlet - Yellow (F), cut:

- (8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Stripe - Sand (G):

- Fussy cut (2) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Beach Toys - White (H), cut:

- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Beach Balls - Blue (I), cut:

- (1) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

From the Sandy Beach Scene - Sand (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61 " x Length of Fabric (LOF) strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 48 " x 61 " back.

Sewing Instructions

- Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim unit to measure 7 " x 7 ". Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

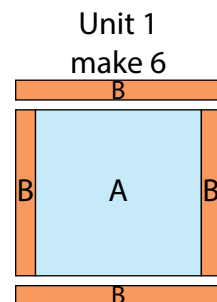

Trim unit to measure 7 " x 7 " **AFTER** adding borders

- Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 7 " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

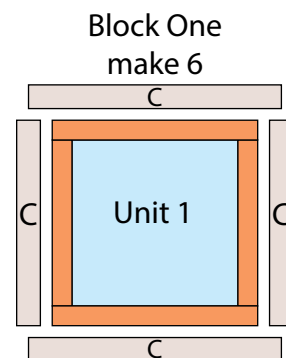

- Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Trim unit to measure 7 " x 7 ". Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

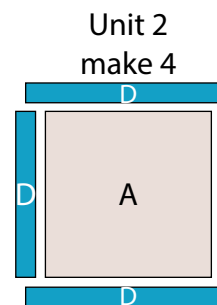

Trim unit to measure 7 " x 7 " **AFTER** adding borders

- Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 7 " Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.

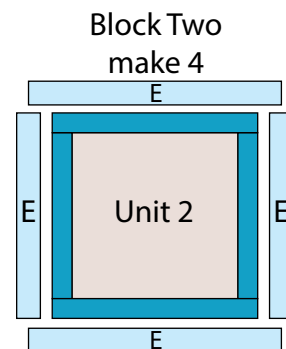

5. Place (1) 3 3/8" Fabric C square on top of (1) 3 3/8" Fabric B square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 5). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6) to make two Unit 3 squares (Fig. 7). Trim blocks to measure 3" square. Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 squares total.

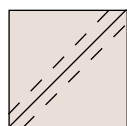

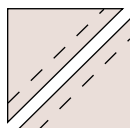

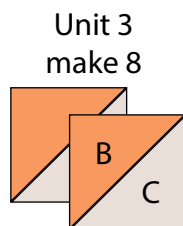

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 8-9 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) Unit 4 squares and (8) Unit 5 squares.

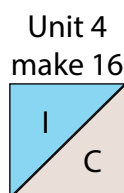

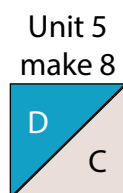

7. Sew together (2) Unit 3 squares to make (1) Bottom Block Strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make (1) Top Block Strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew the Top Block Strip to the top of the Bottom Block Strip to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Block Three square.

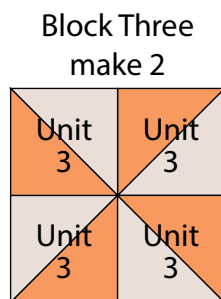

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figures 11-12 for unit identifications and orientations to make (4) Block Four squares and (2) Block Five squares.

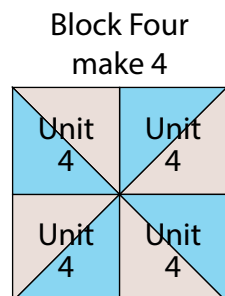

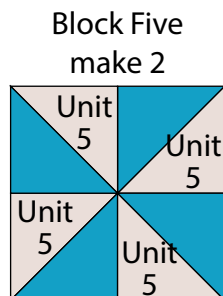

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

9. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them, to make Row Four. Repeat to make Row Twelve.

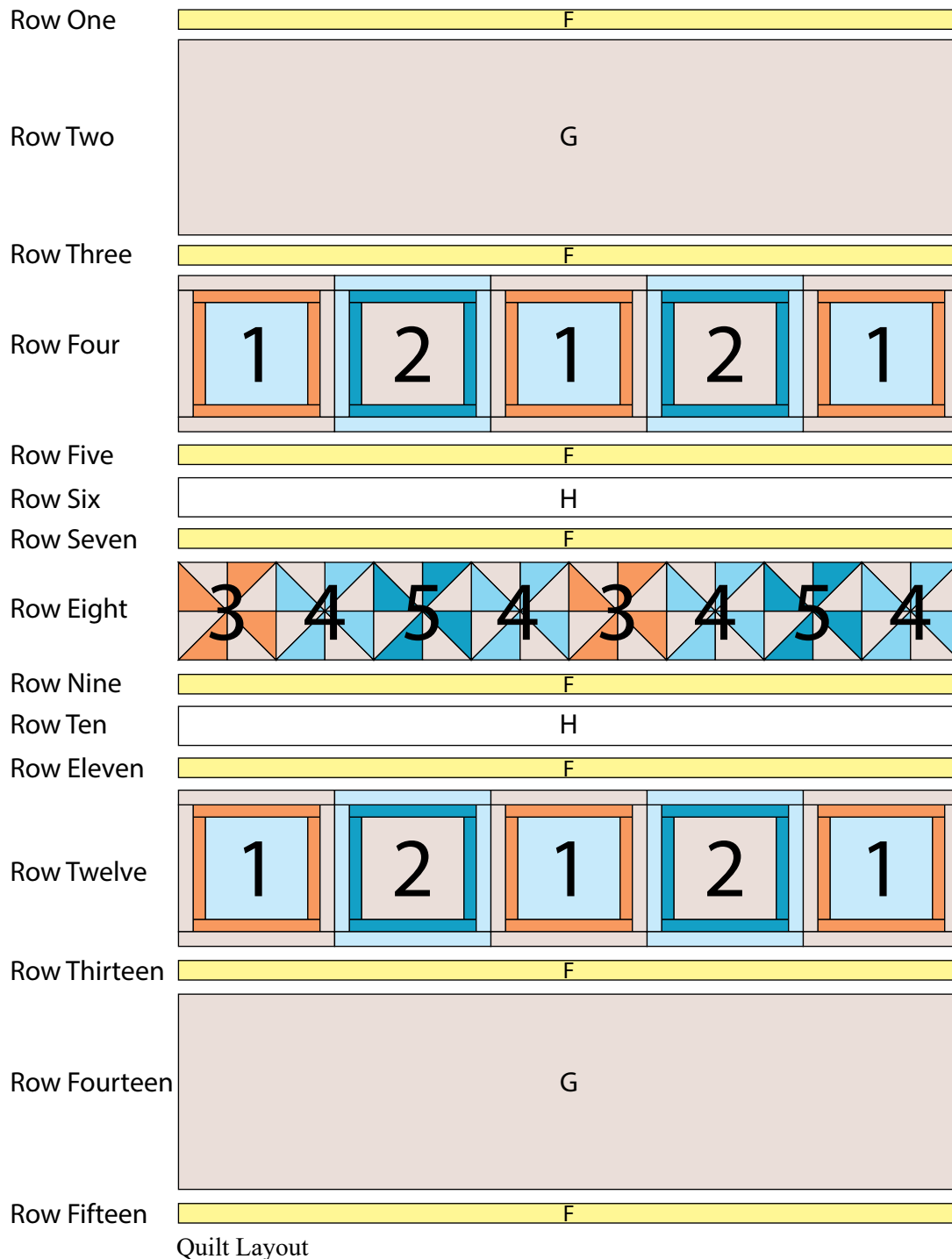
10. Sew together (2) Block Three squares, (4) Block Four squares and (2) Block Five squares to make Row Eight.

11. Sew together (8) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric F strips, (2) 10 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric G strips, Row Four, (2) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric H strips, Row Eight and Row Twelve to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.



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
