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

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23 1/2" x 43 1/2" panel.

From the Urban Legend - Ivory (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Words - Black (C), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Multi Instruments - Gray (D), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Chocolate (E), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 65 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Instruments - Tan (F), cut:

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 67 1/2" strips.
- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 59 1/2" strips.

From the Notes - Light Gray (G), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 10 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Charcoal (H), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Clef templates.

From the Patch - Tan (Backing), cut:

- (2) 87" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 67" x 87" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 43 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25 1/2" x 45 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
4. Refer to Figure 2 to arrange and press (1) Clef symbol onto (1) 10 1/2" Fabric G square.
5. Finish the raw edges of the shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (4) Block One squares total.



7. Sew (5) 5 1/2" Fabric C squares and (4) 5 1/2" Fabric D squares together, alternating them. Sew (5) 5 1/2" Fabric D squares and (4) 5 1/2" Fabric C squares together, alternating them. Sew the (2) resulting sewn strips together lengthwise to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



8. Sew (3) 5 1/2" Fabric D squares and (2) 5 1/2" Fabric C squares together, alternating them. Sew (3) 5 1/2" Fabric C squares and (2) 5 1/2" Fabric D squares together, alternating them. Sew the (2) resulting sewn strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 strip.

9. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 5). Pay attention to the block orientations.



10. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 6). Pay attention to the block orientations.

Bottom Border



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout on Page 4 while assembling.*)

11. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 65 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 67 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 59 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.


15. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.


16. Bind as desired.
