





1 yard	Starlet - Turquoise (F)	6383-Turquoise
1/4 yard	Roosters - Blue (G)	9686-77
1/2 yard	Tossed Farm Animals - Ivory (H)	9684-41
1/4 yard	Cows - Green (I)	9687-66
1/2 yard	Starlet - Yellow (J)	6383-Yellow
4 1/2 yards	Farm Scenic - Green (Backing)	9680-66

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Panel - Green (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 20 1/2" x 40 1/2" panel.

#### From the Starlet - Royal (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 23 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Tractors - Light Blue (C), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 3 1/2" x 22 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Apples - Ivory (D), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

#### From the Starlet - Red (E), cut:

- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (10) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Starlet - Turquoise (F), cut:

- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (10) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.

#### From the Roosters - Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Tossed Farm Animals - Ivory (H), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Cows - Green (I), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Starlet - Yellow (J), cut:


- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 70 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 53 1/2" strips.

#### From the Farm Scenic - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 81" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 81" back.


### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 23 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" to make the (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1).



2. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 block. Sew (1) 3 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 3 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 2 block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).



4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric G square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 3 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 blocks total.

5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.





6. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Figures 6-7 for fabric identification and location to make (10) Block Two squares and (6) Block Three squares.





### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

7. Sew (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block Three squares together, alternating them. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block Three square. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the new strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 2" x 70 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 53 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
