

1/8 yard	Urban Legend - Chartreuse (I)	7101-60

1/8 yard	Chameleon Basics - Olive (L)	1178-62

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Plant Display - Light Pink (A), cut:

• (2) 9 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 9 ³/₄" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Geometric - White (B), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (25) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 9 ¾" strips.

From the Chameleon Basics - Slate (C), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 45" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 41" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Urban Legend - White (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ³/₄" x 42 ¹/₂" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 1 ³/₄" x 39" WOF strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1" x 3" strips.
- (5) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1" x 9 \(^3\)4" strips.
- (10) Template 1 triangles.
- (10) Template 2 triangles.

From the Hanging Plants - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2" x 3" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 1 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (5) Template 1 triangles.
- (5) Template 2 triangles.

From the Watering Cans - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2" x 3" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 1 1/4" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (5) Template 1 triangles.
- (5) Template 2 triangles.

From the Potted Plants - White (G), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 47" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" x 53" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Urban Legend - Olive (H), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Small Leaves.

From the Urban Legend - Chartreuse (I), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Large Leaves.

From the Allover Leaves - Green (J), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Large Leaves.

From the Chameleon Basics - Green Tea (K), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Small Leaves.

From the Chameleon Basics - Olive (L), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Small Leaves.

From the Cactus - Green (M), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Large Leaves.

From the Urban Legend - Hunter (N), cut:

• See instructions to cut (10) Stems.

From the Tossed Plants - White (Backing), cut:

• (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 67" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew together along their long sides (1) Fabric D Template 1 triangle and (1) Fabric E Template 1 triangle to make (1) 1 ³/₄" x 3" Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (5) Unit 1 rectangles total.








2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (5) Unit 2 rectangles, (5) Unit 3 rectangles and (5) Unit 4 rectangles.



3. Sew (1) 1" x 3" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 1 rectangle (1) 2" x 3" Fabric E strip, (1) Unit 2 rectangle and (1) 1" x 3" Fabric D strip together lengthwise and in that order left to right to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (5) Unit 5 strips total.



4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (5) Unit 6 strips.



5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) 6 ½" x 9 ¾" Fabric A strip to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (10) Block One rectangles total.




- 6. Sew together (1) 5 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 5 ½" Fabric E strip and (1) Unit 5 strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (5) Unit 7 strips total.
- 7. Sew (1) 1" x 9 ¾" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 strip. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (5) Unit 8 strips total.



- 8. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 9. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 10. Refer to Figure 10 and the Placement Drawing on Page 5 to arrange and press the (1) Fabric H small leaf, (1) Fabric I large leaf, (1) Fabric J large leaf, (1) Fabric K small leaf, (1) Fabric L small leaf, (1) Fabric M large leaf and (1) Fabric N stem onto (1) Unit 8 strip.
- 11. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Two rectangle.
- 12. Using your favorite embroidery method, embroider the small stems on the leaves.
- 13. Repeat Steps 10-12 to make (5) Block Two rectangles total.







14. Repeat Steps 6-12 and refer to Figures 11-13 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (5) Block Three rectangles.



15. Sew (5) 1 ½" Fabric C squares and (4) 1 ½" x 9 ¾" Fabric B strips together end to end and alternating them from top to bottom to make (1) Block Four strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (6) Block Four strips.




16. Follow Figure 15 and sew together the (6) Block Four strips, (10) Block One rectangles, (5) Block Two rectangles and (5) Block Three rectangles to make the 36 ½" x 42 ½" Center Block.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
17. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 42 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 39" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 45" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 41" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 19. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 47" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 53" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 20. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 21. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 22. Bind as desired.





Quilt Layout
